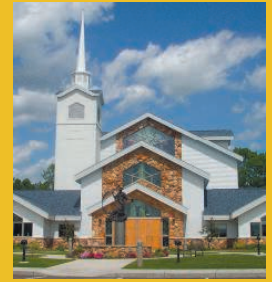

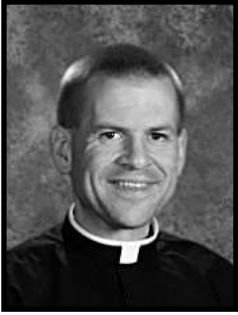

Reflections from Fr. Derek Sakowski



Pastoral Planning Update

As has become customary for early May, Bishop Callahan last week announced various new assignments for priests, which are scheduled to take effect July 5. Those are listed in this week's bulletin.

Obviously the one nearest and dearest to us is our own Fr. Thelen being named as parochial administrator (soon enough to be pastor) of 3 parishes: Alma Center, Fairchild, and Fairview. His warm and winning personality didn't take long to endear the hearts of many of you in just one year here. We will miss him! He will do very well in his new assignment. Who knows? Maybe they will even make him Dean...

People often ask why Bishop Callahan can't just leave priests where they are. He certainly wants to do that whenever possible! But with 160 parishes (soon to be 161), he also has the task of making sure all of our people are well cared for. Staffing those 160 parishes is somewhat like fielding a baseball team. In theory, you could just grab a random group of guys and plug them into the random positions on the field. Certainly every baseball team has its utility players that can be plugged in at many positions. Others cannot. Not all are equipped to pitch, to play shortstop, or to sprint in the outfield. Some might even refuse to play at one position – or if they do it (grudgingly) you know that the results will be less than desirable. Bishop Callahan has told us priests more than once that he won't move us somewhere if he knows we will be dragging our feet going there – it's not fair to the people.

There is also the shortage of priests to reckon with. Thankfully that piece is improving – ever so slowly. When I was ordained in 2003, the average age of our priests was 70. It is now in the upper 50's. You probably notice how many of the pastors in the area are much younger than they used to be. That bodes well for stability in the long run. But most of us still have a 2nd or 3rd parish.

Meanwhile, our focus needs to shift from "maintenance" to "mission." If we just buckle down and try to hold on for dear life to our 160 parishes and several dozen schools, we will wither and die. Jesus encourages us to go out and bear fruit that will last. He sends us out to evangelize.

When I was ordained in 2003, there were 240,000 Catholics on the books in our diocese. Today, that number has dropped to 150,000. That should catch our attention. If we do not begin to look outside the walls of our own parishes and figure out how to attract souls to Christ, we are in for a rude awakening. That needs to be the task of every single parishioner, not just the priests. We cannot cling to what is familiar and comfortable – unless we are comfortable with empty and dying churches. I, for one, am not.

Additionally, we need to open our eyes to realize that Catholi-

cism in the Diocese of La Crosse is not going to be a homogenous bunch of white people. The last Wisconsin census revealed that our entire state is 6% Hispanic – and that is now 8-year old news. We can expect a much higher number in 2020. Moreover, if you look at families with children, the percentage is drastically larger. Almost all of the Hispanics in our area have school-aged children, most of whom are U.S. Citizens. In some of our communities (such as Abbotsford and Arcadia) there are far more Mexicans than Americans – both in the schools and at Mass on Sunday. Even here at St. Mary's, 10 out of our 28 children who made their First Holy Communion this spring were of Mexican descent. St. Raymond's also has hundreds of Mexicans – in Strum, Augusta, and elsewhere. We have not yet figured out how to connect with them and get them to find a home in our parish. There could be as many as 50,000 Mexican Catholics at large in our diocese. That would be a 33% spike to our 150,000 registered members!

I've been working hard with the leadership of Regis Catholic Schools to break through the culture barrier and get some of our Hispanic families enrolled. It is a foreign concept for most of them. In Mexico, only wealthy children or very gifted children have the ability to attend a Catholic school. They just assume that it's not an option for them. We finally had some breakthroughs this year, and had a few families enroll. Hopefully word of mouth will bring many others – even some of those who are not presently church goers.

As most of you know by now, I also made substantial changes to the staffing situation at St. Mary's. We absolutely needed some bilingual staff. For one thing, I had to stop personally playing the role of Secretary and DRE for every Spanish-speaking family. Secondly, native speakers can play this role so much better than I can, and help us turn a corner in evangelizing these families in our midst.

Perhaps the most exciting piece this year is the surprise announcement of the launching of a Hmong Parish in Wausau, to be shepherded by Fr. Al Burkhardt. I am super excited about this historic moment and will share more next week.

Sacraments

Baptism: Parents should request the baptism of their infants at least two months prior to the anticipated date of baptism. A class for parents is required. See your parish website for more information, to download forms, and to see upcoming baptismal class dates.

Marriage: Couples who want to request the celebration of the Sacrament of Marriage should contact the pastor at the time of formal engagement or at least six months prior to the anticipated date of marriage.

Anointing of the Sick: Those who are seriously ill or have been sick for a long period of time should receive the Sacrament of the Sick and Holy Communion. Please call one of the parish offices to make arrangements.

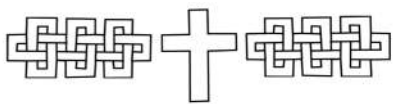
