



"UPON THIS ROCK..." With Holy Name of Jesus Church's interior complete and services held in the new building, there was no need for the old St. Mary Magdalene Church. The old building was turned into classrooms and a parish hall that was known as "Haider Hall" and was used until 1903. All that remains of the original St Mary Magdalene Church is the altar cross from the original altar. By that time a new school was needing to be built and the building had to be moved. The parish decided to donate the old church to the Ahavas Sholom Jewish Community in Sheboygan to serve as their new temple. It was moved to North 13th Street and Geele Avenue where it stood until the new Temple was erected on North Avenue. For many years there was a struggle to have the building declared a landmark, but none came to fruition and it was razed in the 1980's. Through the sharing of this historical building, the bonds of ecumenism grew to become a lasting friendship between our communities. Not only did our beloved Church of St. Mary Magdalene become the rock on which our parish was founded, but it also became the rock on which the Jewish people also worshiped!

The North Side Christian Food Pantry located at St. Dominic is looking to add members to its Board of Directors. The corporation has three officer positions: President, Vice-President/Secretary, and Treasurer. The Board also has Members At Large and currently there are four. A meeting is held once a year with an occasional additional meeting called when needed. The pantry is organized exclusively for charitable purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

The Board:

- Sets policy of the pantry
- Sets strategic direction of the pantry
- Oversees the financial and physical operation of the pantry

Volunteer hours to assist with the weekly operation of the pantry are not required of Board members. Occasional visitation during pantry hours is appreciated. The main requirement is a desire to help people in our community who struggle with food insecurity, following the mission of Jesus.

DID YOU KNOW???

Did you Know - that on March 27, 2020 the Coronavirus Aid, Relief and Economic Security (CARES) Act was signed into law. The CARES Act increases tax deductions for charitable donations for both individuals and corporations for tax year 2020. You may wish to consider the following provisions when determining your charitable gifts this year. Individuals who do not itemize their tax deductions may have a new, “above the line” charitable tax deduction of \$300 per tax payer (\$600 for a married couple). An “above the line” deduction reduces a donor’s adjusted gross income and thereby reduces taxable income. Individuals who do itemize may deduct up to 100% of their 2020 adjusted gross income, up from the previous limit of 60%. Corporations may deduct up to 25% of taxable income, up from the previous 10%. To qualify for these special deductions, contributions must be made during the tax year 2020. Payments on outstanding pledges also qualify, providing the payment is made in 2020.



