Father's Message

We say Happy Easter for 50 days in the Church, because Easter is that important. We say Merry Christmas until the Feast of the Epiphany, which ends our Christmas season. It is traditionally the 6th of January, but it is a bit early this year.



Epiphany needs to be celebrated. It is important, but again, nothing is more important than Easter and its 50 days of celebration. As a Church, we have two long penitential seasons – Advent and Lent. But have you noticed how many feasts and celebrations we have? Next week, we celebrate the Baptism of the Lord to usher in Ordinary Time again. Jesus was a thirty year old adult at His baptism. On February 2, we circle back to the baby Jesus, and celebrate the Presentation of the Lord at the Temple, which is 40 days after His birth. We celebrate the milestones in the life of Jesus, and the highlights of what Jesus means to us.

Again, today is the Epiphany and, it is really great for us to contemplate. Jesus was born as King of the Jews, but God did not leave us out of the mix, so to speak. The Magi, who pursued the newborn King, are the ones who recognized the symbolic nature of the times. Most likely astrologers, their travels would have made them very familiar with the Jewish traditions, and they would have been aware that a huge event of God was on the timeline in prophecy. Jerusalem was on a major trade route, so the Scriptures were a familiar thing, even if they were not Jewish. Their excitement was peaked as God used a star as a symbol for them to interpret what Herod and the religious could not do. God was inviting the whole world to be a part of His miraculous offer of salvation through the Gentile magi. The light of the World was here and the Gentiles had now become a part of the revealed plan of God, that all are welcome. The baby will gather everyone from the farthest reaches of the earth, like the Magi. No one is unwelcome. Consider this the invitation for all of us, at all times. Merry Christmas until next year!





The pantry is organized exclusively for charitable purposes under section 501(c)(3) of the Internal Revenue Code.

- Oversees the financial and physical operation of the pantry

Volunteer hours to assist with the weekly operation of the pantry are not required of Board members. Occasional visits

during pantry hours are appreciated. The main requirement is a desire to help people in our community who struggle with food insecurity, following the mission of Jesus.
