## Grace and peace to all!





## SIGNIFICANT UPGRADE FROM CHUCK DIDDIA, HOUSE CHAIR

Though we will not be able to enjoy the benefits this year, I look forward to the summer of 2024. On October 17<sup>th</sup> our HVAC contractor started work on air conditioning the sanctuary. All work was completed on the 20<sup>th</sup>. The system is manufactured by Mitsubishi Electronics. We will have two three-ton units outdoors on the east side of the sanctuary and two units mounted on the wall of the east sanctuary wall. We have asked John Brooks, Tru-Guard, Inc. to protect the outside units and secure them from theft. I am hopeful that this improvement will stimulate better attendance in the summertime, and we will all be more comfortable. This is really exciting!


