ADVENT MEANINGS

During Advent, which begins this year on December 3, many churches and families use wreaths to symbolize watchfulness and increasing joy as Christmas approaches. Colors for the candles vary, with some traditions using blue (for hope or creation) and others preferring purple (for royalty, humility, or penitence).



The four candles that each represent a week in Advent also signify hope, peace, joy, and love. (The third candle is often pink.) In the center is the white Christ candle, representing Jesus as the light of the world. That candle is lit on Christmas Eve and Christmas Day.

The round, green Advent wreath has special meaning of its own. It symbolizes eternal life and the unending love of God, who sent his only Son to earth to die in our place.



JOIN THE BETHANY UNION FAMILY FOR A SPECIAL CELTIC WORSHIP SERVICE ON WEDNESDAY, DECEMBER 21, AT 7P.

From the <u>Transceltic</u> by <u>Alastair Kneale</u> on December 23, 2017: The Winter solstice was seen by the ancient Celts as one of the most significant times of the year. Druids, the priestly class in ancient Celtic society, celebrated the festival of Alban Arthuan (also known as Yule.) The Yule log burnt by the Celts was to counter the darkness of mid-winter when they thought the sun stood still for twelve days and to bring good luck. Many of the burial chambers and monuments scattered throughout the Celtic nations were constructed to capture the full impact of the sun's rays during the solstices.

It was also a time when they ceremonially gathered mistletoe from oak trees for its magical and health-giving properties. (A practice described in the writings of Roman historian Pliny the Elder (Gaius Plinius Secundus AD 23 – August 25, AD 79)). The Holly and ivy were evergreens the Celts considered important to keep evil spirits at bay.





JOHN RUSKIN (1819-1900) WAS AN ENGLISH AUTHOR AND TEACHER AT OXFORD UNIVERSITY. There is a memorial to Ruskin on the shores of Derwentwater in the Lake District. Under a Celtic Cross on the memorial are the following words:

"The Spirit of God is around you in the air you breathe. His glory is in the light you see and in the fruitfulness of the earth and the joy of his creation. He has written for you day by day his revelation, and he has granted you day by day your daily bread."


