In March, we have several extraordinary Sundays, including Girl Scout Sunday on March 10, 2024, when we recognize and celebrate with our Bethany Union Girl Scout Troop as they participate in our worship service.

Towards the end of the month, we celebrate Holy Week 2024, beginning with our All-Church Family Holy Week Communion

Breakfast on Saturday, March 23, 2024. In the past, this was an event that only included the men of Bethany Union. Beginning this year, the Communion Breakfast, as a special inaugural celebration of Holy Week, will be open to the entire church: women and children, as well as men. The event begins promptly at 8:00 a.m. in the Sanctuary, where we celebrate with a Service of Holy Communion and then move into Fellowship Hall for a fellowship breakfast and Holy Week program. This is a joyful and delightful way to usher in Holy Week, and I pray we all take advantage of this gathering and participate.

We then begin Holy Week with our Palm Sunday celebration on Sunday, March 24, 2024. We will recall and re-member our Lord's triumphant entry into Jerusalem with the waving of Palm branches and shouts of hosanna to our King. This is all in anticipation of Resurrection Sunday on March 31, 2024, when we go to the tomb to discover that he is not there! The Sanctuary is adorned with Easter flowers, and the cross is draped with a white linen cloth, reminding us of the burial clothes left in the grave. This is the pinnacle of our Christian year and of our faith. It is all about the Resurrection - His and ours. Come and worship and participate in the timeless story of our salvation. He is alive!








Welcome Spring 3/19

Thankfully, so far this winter (minimal snow) we have only had to pay one snow removal bill. Please pray with me that that trend continues till we find spring. So far, other than paying some significant heating bills, we have experienced only two maintenance issues. One is that after waiting way too long, we have had the floors in the kitchen and social hall professionally stripped and waxed. This was long overdue and has made a significant improvement in appearance. The other issue is that we had a craftsman repair and caulk both showers in the Howe House. That work was finished on Feb 26th. The shower in the master bedroom has been leaking, and now we are confronted with having some drywall replaced on the kitchen ceiling and having it repainted. So far, in 2024, it has been necessary to withdraw \$17,000 from our Vanguard investment account to meet cash flow needs. I cannot overemphasize the importance of staying current with your financial commitments if you have made one. We are very fortunate to have this fund to fall back on when needs arise. We are looking forward to better days and improved cash flow. On a brighter note, Andrew Greene, our Treasurer-Elect, has been spending time with Terry Peterson and me, getting familiar with the routines and processes associated with the Treasurer's office. He'll be soooo ready in 2025!

OUT WITH THE OLD IN WITH THE NEW

For the last several years after we held our successful "Men's Communion Breakfast", I would be approached by some people in our congregation asking why just men? INTRODUCING Dr. CANDACE LAUGHINGHOUSE OUR 2024 LEGACY LECTURE SPEAKER



Dr Candace Laughinghouse began her personal transformation by theological education from the Candler School of Theology (MDiv), Duke Divinity School (ThM) and Chicago Theological Center (PhD) with a pedestrian interest in the Black church. Her transformation into antispeciesist ecowomanism forged beyond any particular religious denomination, thus allowing her to experience a consciousness of God and of herself as the Imago Dei. In the power and knowledge of this transformation, she continues to evolve into this newness of caring for creation by highlighting shared oppressions and indigenous perspectives as a more authentic theory and praxis in social justice that includes all of Creation. Dr. Laughinghouse's work within interfaith projects, lectures and writings inform her research and energizes her to understand that while humans may be culturally

different, we are elementally identical as we breathe the same air.

As such, Laughinghouse is an emerging leader in eco-justice and animal justice to save the planet, our families, and humanity's future quality of life. She currently teaches at St. Augustine's University and is a recipient of various consults and teaching fellowships. Dr. Laughinghouse also serves on the board of the Womanist Approaches to Religion and Society, the Black Religious Scholars Group, the Culture and Arts Foundation, Minding Animals, inc., and recently contributed to an online lectionary centralizing farm animals through CreatureKind. Her greatest commitment and accomplishment is her three young daughters and raising them in the awareness of God's love for all Creation.
