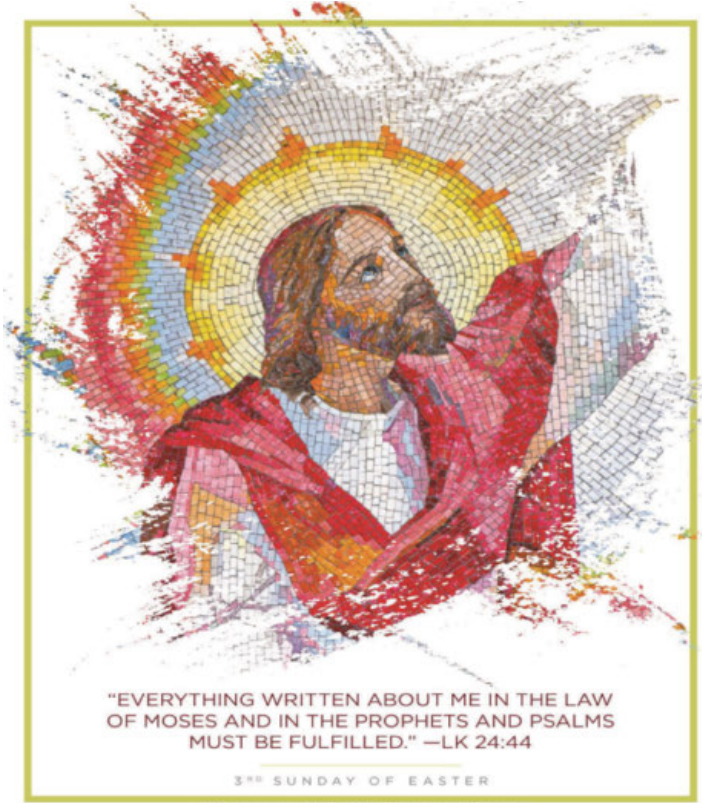

We are introducing children's books for your child's use in church during the Mass.
