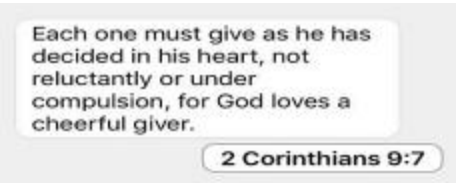

- 11 Signs and Symptoms of Too Much Stress:** Stress is defined as a state of mental or emotional strain caused by adverse circumstances. At some point, most people deal with feelings of stress. In fact, one study found that 33% of adults reported experiencing high levels of perceived stress. The condition is associated with a long list of physical and mental symptoms.
1. Acne - When people are feeling stressed they tend to touch their faces more often, which may spread bacteria and contribute to acne.
 2. Headaches - One study of 267 people with chronic headaches found that a stressful event preceded the development of chronic headaches in about 45% of cases.
 3. Chronic Pain - Aches and pains are a common complaint that can result from increased levels of stress. Increased levels of the stress hormone cortisol may be associated with chronic pain.
 4. Frequent Sickness - If you feel like you're constantly battling a case of the sniffles, stress may be to blame. Stress can take a toll on your immune system and can increase susceptibility to infections.
 5. Decreased Energy and Insomnia - Chronic fatigue and decreased energy levels can also be caused by prolonged stress. Stress may also disrupt sleep and cause insomnia, which can lead to low energy.
 6. Changes in Libido - Many people experience changes in their sex drives during stressful periods.
 7. Digestive Issues - Problems like diarrhea and constipation can also be caused by high levels of stress. Stress may affect those with digestive disorders such as irritable bowel syndrome or inflammatory bowel disease, also causing stomach pain and bloating.
 8. Appetite Changes - Appetite changes are common during times of stress. You may find yourself with no appetite at all or ravenously raiding the refrigerator in the middle of the night.
 9. Depression - Chronic stress may very well contribute to the development of depression.
 10. Rapid Heartbeat and 11. Sweating - are also very common when exposed to stressful situations.
