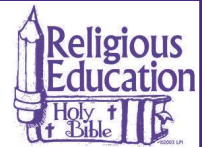
2017 BETTY FILPI DIOCESAN COUNCIL OF CATHOLIC WOMEN SCHOLARSHIP

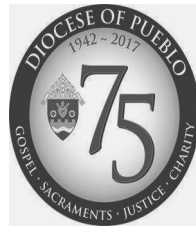
NEW THIS YEAR

- **Reconciliation**
Monte Vista ~ Confessions Sat. 4pm or by appointment
Center ~ Confessions Sunday 11am
Del Norte ~ Confessions During Priest Availability Days, Tue & Fri
**Missions before or after weekend masses.
 Children receive 1st Reconciliation with 1st Communion. Must have also been in Religious Ed the previous year.

- **Communion**
 Children are eligible to receive First Holy Communion as early as 3rd grade. Must have 2 consecutive years of Religious Ed. classes.

- **Confirmation**
 Students are eligible to begin preparation in 9th grade. Two consecutive years are required to complete the sacrament.
