¿Tienes sed de amor? Yo te saciaré y te llenaré. ¿Tienes sed de ser amado?, te amo más de lo que te puedes imaginar.... hasta el punto de morir en la cruz por tí.

TENGO SED DE TI. Si, esa es la única manera en que apenas puedo empezar a describir mi amor.

TENGO SED DE TI. Tengo sed de amarte y de que tú me ames. Tan precioso eres para mí que TENGO SED DE TI. Ven a Mí y llenaré tu corazón y sanaré tus heridas. Te haré una nueva creación y te daré la paz aún en tus pruebas.

TENGO SED DE TI. Nunca debes dudar de Mi Misericordia, de mi deseo de perdonarte, de Mi anhelo por bendecirte y vivir Mi vida en tí.
