CONFESS — PLEASE!

The Jewish people had a group system of confessing once a year. They would honestly, in prayer, examine their hearts and in the name of all the people, they would sacrifice a goat. The goat would be the animal to atone for all of the sins of the community.

The followers of Jesus saw how He would often say to someone, "Go, your sins are forgiven," or, "Go, and sin no more!"

Christ, preparing the Apostles to continue the mission after His crucifixion, said very clearly, "you are to do what I have done. Whatever sins you have forgiven, they will, in heaven, be forgiven."

St. James said, "Confess your sins one to another." The "other" was someone who you believed to be a person of wisdom.

The idea was rooted in the hearts of the Apostles, but they were not always available. At those times, there was a delegation of followers of Jesus with the wisdom to discuss and forgive.

Later in time this was the responsibility of a Bishop who in turn delegated this to the priests (which means "one of age and wisdom").

The Church, again, at a later date asked that the faithful should confess one's sins at least once a year at, or around, Easter time. They left out the goat!

Today, most Parishes have time for confession or as it is now called, "The Sacrament of Reconciliation." So in this time of coming Easter, I say, Confess – Please! It is good for the soul!

Cuarto Domingo de Cuaresma

Hace ya tal vez un año, que alguien de la parroquia compartió conmigo algo que él practica: cuando conoce a alguien, trata de encontrar en esa persona algo positivo, para así, fijarse en lo bueno, y evitar fijarse en lo malo.

Me pareció algo muy bueno. Encontrar un detalle, algo bueno y particular de cada quien, es una sana práctica de ayudarnos a fijarnos en los demás con buenos ojos.

De hecho, podríamos preguntarnos qué criterio utilizamos al fijarnos en los demás?

Es muy fácil caer en la vanidad al valorar a alguien basado en cosas superficiales como su estatus social o cuánto dinero tiene; y lo contrario, también suele suceder, es decir, valorar menos al que menos tiene.

Esto me recuerda un dicho que más o menos dice, que los buenos amigos son los que permanecen cuando llegan los momentos difíciles.

Podríamos decir entonces, que la manera de fijarnos en los demás refleja nuestros valores, especialmente si valoramos o no la humildad.

Yo pienso que existe una correspondencia entre saber apreciar y en tener un corazón humilde.

Un corazón arrogante mira con desprecio, mientras que un corazón humilde descubre fijarse en lo que es importante para Dios.

Es difícil ver nuestra propia arrogancia, pero si usamos lenguaje de desprecio para hablar de otras personas, seguramente se esconde la arrogancia en nuestro corazón.

Tanto David, como el ciego del Evangelio de hoy, nos demuestran la humildad del que es consciente que ha recibido de Dios todo lo que tiene.

Son dos ejemplos de muchos otros en la palabra de Dios donde se nos dice que Dios resiste a los soberbios y da su gracia a los humildes. Una y otra vez, a lo largo de la historia de salvación, Dios escogió a los pequeños y sencillos, así como lo hizo con David.
