## **Cristo, El Buen Pastor**

Para los habitantes de Tierra Santa, en la época de Jesús, y en algunas partes todavía hoy en día, los rebaños y los pastos, son realidades de la vida cotidiana de muchas personas de campo.

Muchos humildes campesinos se ganan la vida así.

Ya que esta era una realidad muy común, en la época de Jesús, El se vale de estas realidades cotidianas para describir su relación con su pueblo.

Desde mucho antes de Cristo, el pueblo de Israel sabía que necesitaba un pastor, de lo contrario, se dispersarían, y correrían el riesgo de ante sus enemigos.

Cuando el pueblo de Israel le pide un rey a Dios, ellos lo hicieron, en parte, porque querían mantenerse unidos, y creían que un rey sería como un pastor que los mantuviera unidos.

Pero el reino no duró unido sino dos generaciones, y luego tanto en el reino del norte como en el del sur, la mayoría de los reyes se enfocaron fue en sus propios intereses, y no veían por el bien del pueblo.

En el libro de los Números, del Antiguo Testamento, un pueblo sin guía que lo oriente es comparado con un grupo de ovejas sin pastor.

Así mismo le pareció a Jesús cuando se encontraba ante las muchedumbres de gente: "...cuando vio las multitudes, tuvo compasión de ellas; porque estaban acosadas y desamparadas como ovejas sin pastor" (Marcos 6:34; Mateo 9:36).

Los profetas a lo largo de la historia de Salvación recordaban al Pueblo, que Dios es el pastor.

Por ejemplo, antes de que el pueblo regresara de su exilio nuevamente a su tierra, el profeta Isaías les anuncia: "Como un pastor, El Señor apacentará su rebaño; con su brazo lo reunirá.

A los corderitos llevará en su seno, y conducirá con cuidado a las que todavía están criando" (Isaías 40:11). Tal vez Jesús meditó mucho sobre estas palabras, en vista de su propia misión.

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
