**SINS AGAINST THE HOLY SPIRIT**

In the first article of the series about Blasphemes against the Holy Spirit we reflected on how Jesus warns that a house that is divided against itself cannot stand. Standing guard of our treasures, as to put them under Lock and Key, is not the way to be strong enough to protect them. Rather one must participate in the gifts to recognize that their value is worth more than the sleep of worldly lure. Being "tied up" begins with each and every little thread of sin that slowly binds us to the ground... to the earthly desire... and takes away our freedom. This leads us to forget the value of the Spiritual gifts and denounce them (blaspheme) which leads to certain death. For the next six weeks I would like to discuss each "sin" in more detail and a strategy to combat such temptation.

SAVE US FROM THE SIN OF JUDAS!!!

*yourself." * Flinging the money into the temple, he departed and went off and hanged himself." (Matthew 27:1-5)*

Judas is the perfect example of the sin of despair! Was there ever a greater sin than that of Judas? To betray... to plot and plan for the "handing over" of the Son of God... To do so with a kiss? In Caravaggio's painting of Judas betrayal he depicts not only the Kiss of (Jesus') death but the turning of Jesus' face; eyes cast down and complete chaos that followed the act! Jesus would be led to his death to forgive us our sins... all sins... yes even those as traitorous as Judas betrayal!

"Look to it Yourself"

The scripture is very "telling" when it comes to Judas seeking forgiveness from the chief priests and elders.

They, the chief priests and elders, not willing to forgive as Jesus was capable of doing suggest to Judas to take matters into his own hands. Judas allowed himself to be "tied up" in his guilt... the recognition of his heinous act and the betrayal of the only real love he had ever encountered... led to the inability to believe, trust or hope for forgiveness from Jesus.. so Judas took matters into his own hands.

The hanging of Judas is contrary to God's goodness and Justice. Once despair entered his heart, Judas acts upon himself with hatred and condemnation and fails to seek, wait and trust in the power of the Cross and the Blood of Mercy!!

We know that Judas' sin could have been forgiven... In fact we saw such forgiveness come to Peter who denied Christ, another form of betrayal if you will, but repented and sought to be renewed in the powerful love of His Savior!! Not only was Peter forgiven and restored to Grace... He was once again the rock on which Christ built His Church!

Despair - "By despair, we cease to hope for our personal salvation from God, for help in attaining it or for the forgiveness of our sins. Despair is contrary to God's goodness, to his justice - for the Lord is faithful to his promises and to his Mercy." (CCC # 2091)

"Then Judas, his betrayer, seeing that Jesus had been condemned, deeply regretted what he had done. He returned the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and elders, saying, "I have sinned in betraying innocent blood." They said,

Is Judas in Hell?

This is always the question that is asked about the betrayal of Jesus by Judas. The answer depends on Judas and not the Lord. If Judas acted truly out of despair not believing that he could be saved then his final act was that of Blasphemy! This then, hanging himself in despair, would have been the worse sin far greater than his betrayal! But if Judas, at the moment he hung himself, repented and cried out for mercy it would surely have been granted him!

Despair is a very hopeless disposition that cuts us off from a life of grace and the recognition that our life matters in the mission of Christ and the fulfillment of the new kingdom. When self love wanes it makes it impossible to have faith and see past our brokenness and the healing power of God. Despair can also lead us to another Blasphemy of the Holy Spirit: Presumption. This we will discuss next week.

How to Combat Despair**Never take matters into your own hands**

Satan will always suggest, like the chief priest and elders, for one who is in great sin "To see to it Yourself." This act of self judgment and pity ends the guilt but not the spiritual wound. Healing of any sin or way of life only comes through mercy... life in the spirit... not eternal death!

Sacrament of Reconciliation

Never underestimate the Sacrament of confessing your sins to a priest! It is there that you hear your own voice cry out for forgiveness. It is there that you receive recompense and forgiveness in the crucified Lord. Once you receive absolution you are restored to the grace of your baptism and are renewed in the challenge of the discipleship in Christ!

**Combat "False guilt" with the Divine Mercy Chaplet**

False guilt will always crop up because some sins cause great pain to others and the ongoing consequences can be overwhelming. False guilt is not the same as sorrow for sin. False guilt makes you believe, because of the consequences, your sin was never forgiven. This must be combated with God's Mercy. The Divine Mercy Chaplet begs for that assurance of Mercy and the grace to have courage and live through such circumstances.

NEXT WEEK: (2) Presumption of God's mercy, "There are two kinds of presumption. Either we presume upon our own capacities, (hoping to be able to save ourselves without help from God), or we presume upon God's almighty power or His mercy (hoping to obtain his forgiveness without conversion and glory without merit)." (C.C.C. # 2092)





and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and life of the world to come. Amen.




