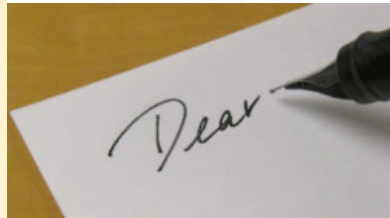

FEAST OF CORPUS CHRISTI: BODY AND BLOOD OF JESUS CHRIST**EMBRACING THE “WHOLE” TEACHING SUMS UP BOTH FEASTS**

Last Sunday we celebrated the Feast of the Holy Trinity, the basic belief of how God has revealed himself to us throughout salvation History. This is the most fundamental teaching that is held by anyone who claims themselves a Christian. But there is more to it than that... in fact much more that is tied up in this week's feast: Corpus Christi. The Eucharist is the true blood and flesh of Christ as well as the necessary belief of anyone seeking fullness with Truth. I share with you the following letter of an adult sister written to her adult brother of how she came to realize what she was ready to walk away from (the Catholic Church) was what she was searching for all along. I title this letter:

**“The real ‘Zinger’ is the Eucharist”**

Hi Paul,

I am writing this email to you to tell you about the latest news in my spiritual journey. I don't know if Mom and Dad have talked to you about this or not...but yesterday (Friday) I met with the priest, went to confession, and was received back into the Catholic Church. I was so excited to receive the Eucharist that

I went to daily Mass. As soon as the Eucharist—the Real Presence of Christ—was on my tongue I was overflowed with emotion and the tears just came! The Lord has been so good to me. He has been guiding me by the hand particularly for the past 5 years since I have opened myself up to Him completely, willing to follow Him where ever He leads. As a matter of fact, I can admit that I was becoming **anti-Catholic**. I felt that Catholics didn't “get” the whole picture about Jesus and that many of their teachings were legalistic and man-made. I totally believe that the Lord led me out of the Church. I needed to study His Word and with the help of Praise and Worship I fell in love with Him. I became more dedicated to prayer and Bible study and experienced the joy of Christian fellowship and the deepness of friendship that you can only feel with another Christian. This past summer I felt so connected with Him. I was into a very deep Old Testament study of the tabernacle. I was studying and praying each morning. I was praying the Prayer of Jabez, and praying for the Lord's will in my life each day.

Then, in early August things began to happen. As a Christian, I don't believe in coincidence. That is why I had to stop and pause as many “coincidences” began to happen. To make a long story much shorter I realized that I had simply walked away from the Catholic Church without fully understanding or studying it. I realized that I needed to do some research so I could decide once and for all. As I immersed myself in research (books, apologetics, church history, conversion stories, doctrinal issues, etc.) the lord began to unveil my eyes. One topic at a time I came to see the fullness of the truth of the Church. **For me the zinger was the Eucharist**. The Lord has shown me that WITHOUT A DOUBT that the Eucharist is the Real Presence of Christ. A study of the Greek shows that in John 6 Jesus said to “chew” and “gnaw on” His body for it is “true food” and His blood is “true drink”. WOW! Once I received this (by the way, look at John 6. There is no denying it. Many followers walked away because this—cannibalism—was hard teaching. If He was speaking symbolically what was so hard about that teaching?) I knew that in His perfect timing the Lord would show me everything else I needed to see. Once you understand the Eucharist the entire Good News comes together as never before! The Mass is the wedding supper of the Lamb (Revelation) where Christ and His Church (His Bride) become one flesh!!!

As I said, I prayed and told the Lord that I had to be convinced of everything 100%. One issue at a time was revealed to me. Now I understand the beauty of apostolic succession, the authority of the pope, the gift of Mary, the beauty of Reconciliation (Jesus BREATHED on the apostles and gave them the authority to forgive sin. The only other time we are told of God breathing on man is when he created Adam. He breathed on him to give him life. In the same way Jesus breathed on the apostles. Through reconciliation we receive new life!!) When it was time for me to go to Mass for the first time I was scared. What if I went there and was bored and couldn't find Jesus there? Then what? Well, after reading about the meaning of the Mass and learning more about what the movements of the priest signify I knew it was time to go. Well, can I just say it was like I had never been before in my life. Yes, the liturgy was familiar as I knew the responses to make, but it was all new! Suddenly I could see the beauty and I could see Christ in every part of the Mass. As we moved into the Liturgy of the Eucharist I was overwhelmed. As I watched the priest convert the bread and wine into the body and blood of Christ I couldn't hold back the tears. Jesus was here!!! And not just in Spirit but also in a very real, physical way. This was His gift to His people! His broken body for the forgiveness of sins! Over the last few months we have left our Protestant church and began to establish ourselves again as Catholics. It has been sad as we have had to say some good-byes, but the Lord is using our experience to show many of our Protestant friends the beauty of the Catholic Church.

I could go on and on and on but I won't. I just wanted to share with you the beauty of what I have found. I am not out to "convert you back." Only God Himself can do that. What I do want to do though is to stop you before you make the mistake that I did. Although many Catholics don't understand the beauty and richness of their own faith it is there nonetheless. Many Catholics do understand what they have and they don't need anything else! I made the mistake of misjudging our very own parents. They do understand their faith and I am so thankful that God has allowed me to see that. Don't worry about them. They are just fine! I pray that God will continue to guide you in your life as you seek Him with all of your heart (Jer 29:13)!
