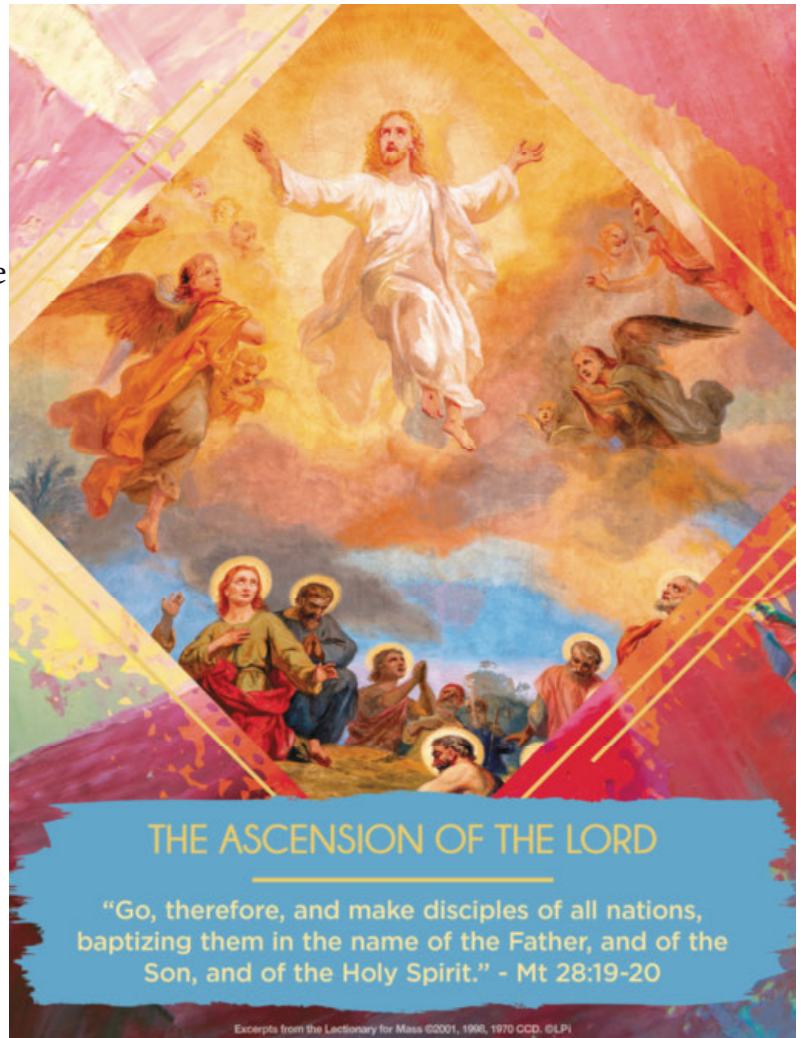

The local VFW honor Guard will present colors and have a 21 gun Salute prior to Mass. Please come early enough to share in this moment of honor for those who served our country.

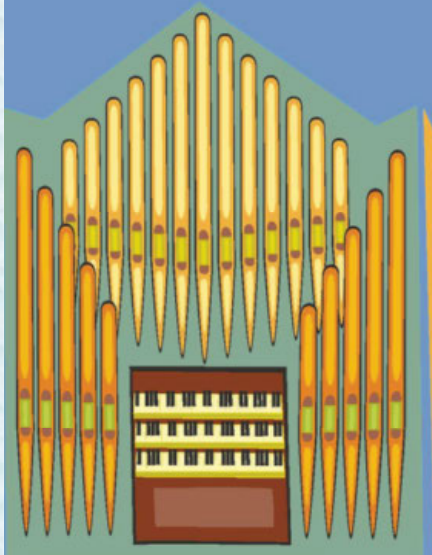
