PASTOR'S NOTES

Pray to your Guardian Angel everyday!

Why? The Church teaches that we each have a Guardian Angel assigned to us to help us.

How does a Guardian Angel help me? A Guardian Angel helps me in 4 ways the prayer teaches us. (To Light and Guard, Rule and Guide)

Common Question: "I don't feel like I have a Guardian Angel. How do I embrace this teaching of the Catholic Church if it doesn't feel like it is true?"

My Answer: You won't feel like this is true until you embrace the help of your Guardian Angel. I practice this in prayer in the following way: I spend a few minutes contemplating the reality that God has assigned an Angel to support me. This Angel, my Guardian Angel, is pure spirit, not weakened by human afflictions, and powerful --for the Guardian Angels always behold the Face of God. This Angel has chosen to love and serve the Lord God always and desires to support me in virtue and in my real life situations in accordance with God's Will. This Angel also does not interfere with or manipulate my free will. This is important because I need to choose to invite my Guardian Angel into all the mess of my human weakness, my shortcomings, fears and failures today, my hopes for tomorrow, and my daily need for the Lord's clarity. So, that's exactly what I've learned to do. I pray, saying; "Dear Guardian Angel, I Love you, and I need your help. I invite you into all these things that I now name about my life. I welcome and invite you into them. (Next, I name all the things on my heart today_____) Please, support me as the Lord God has given you Authority to do. I then conclude with (Angel of God, my guardian dear, to whom God's Love commits me here, ever this day be at my side, to Light and Guard, Rule and Guide.) Amen."

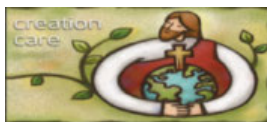

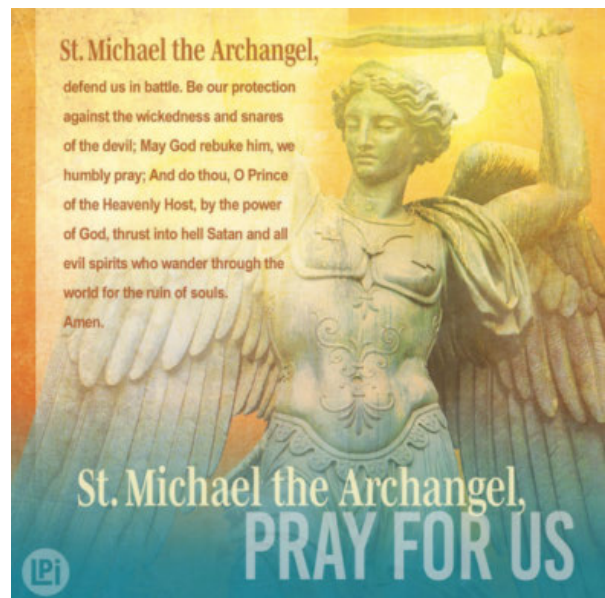
MAGNIFICAT BREAKFAST
