

## **PASTOR'S NOTES**

## Keep at it! Don't give up!

During my first year of seminary formation, one of my professors loved to give very difficult exams. He provided too many essays on the test for the amount of time we had to take it. My seminary Rector said to us, "Oh his tests are impossible, they are impossible! But you'll get an A!" It didn't make sense to me at that moment, but he was right! This Teacher (A Catholic Priest) purposefully gave more questions than could be answered, but he loved effort. He would tell us; "Just choose the questions you know the best and spend time on them...do the best you can with what you know!" I loved this class looking back and I love the way my professor's tests were designed. It was a life lesson for a faithful Catholic.

Sometimes we can get overwhelmed with too many things in our Catholic faith. We put pressure on ourselves and forget that we aren't supposed to solve all the equations or answer all the essays of life. Life has more Essays than we can answer in one lifetime, but God doesn't expect us to conquer every question during the exam of life. He looks at us with great love and support and says something like; "Focus on one thing at a time and really strive to become holy in it! At one time in my life, I got overwhelmed with how many Saints there are in the Church, and with how many books there are I've never read! I realized that I can't read all the books or learn about all the Saints or share my inner life with every one of them. I don't have the capacity, and neither do you. BUT I can sure read some good Catholic books regularly and share my life with some of the Saints God has guided me to know better, and so can you! A little bit of real daily effort goes a long way! As a friend of mine once said; "Life as a Catholic is easy, if you learn to love the Eucharist and to make a good confession regularly, all else will fall into place!"

## GOSPEL READING

Luke 11:1-13

Iesus was praying in a certain place, and when he had finished, one of his disciples said to him, "Lord, teach us to pray just as John taught his disciples." He said to them, "When you pray, say: Father, hallowed be your name, your kingdom come. Give us each day our daily bread and forgive us our sins for we ourselves forgive everyone in debt to us, and do not subject us to the final test." And he said to them, "Suppose one of you has a friend to whom he goes at midnight and says, 'Friend, lend me three loaves of bread, for a friend of mine has arrived at my house from a journey and I have nothing to offer him,' and he says in reply from within, 'Do not bother me; the door has already been locked and my children and I are already in bed. I cannot get up to give you anything.' I tell you, if he does not get up to give the visitor the loaves because of their friendship, he will get up to give him whatever he needs because of his persistence. "And I tell you, ask and you will receive; seek and you will find; knock and the door will be opened to you. For everyone who asks, receives; and the one who seeks, finds; and to the one who knocks, the door will be opened. What father among you would hand his son a snake when he asks for a fish? Or hand him a scorpion when he asks for an egg? If you then, who are wicked, know how to give good gifts to your children, how much more will the Father in heaven give the Holy Spirit to those who ask him?"

The Gospel of the Lord. Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

In those days, the LORD said: "The outcry against Sodom and Gomorrah is so great, and their sin so grave, that I must go down and see whether or not their actions fully correspond to the cry against them that comes to me. I mean to find out." While Abraham's visitors walked on farther toward Sodom, the LORD remained standing before Abraham. Then Abraham drew nearer and said: "Will you sweep away the innocent with the guilty? Suppose there were fifty innocent people in the city; would you wipe out the place, rather than spare it for the sake of the fifty innocent people within it? Far be it from you to do such a thing, to make the innocent die with the guilty so that the innocent and the guilty would be treated alike! Should not the judge of all the world act with justice?" The LORD replied, "If I find fifty innocent people in the city of Sodom, I will spare the whole place for their sake." Abraham spoke up again: "See how I am presuming to speak to my Lord, though I am but dust and ashes! What if there are five less than fifty innocent people? Will you destroy the whole city because of those five?" He answered, "I will not destroy it, if I find forty-five there." But Abraham persisted, saying "What if only forty are found there?" He replied, "I will forbear doing it for the sake of the forty." Then Abraham said, "Let not my Lord grow impatient if I go on. What if only thirty are found there?" He replied, "I will forbear doing it if I can find but thirty there." Still Abraham went on, "Since I have thus dared to speak to my Lord, what if there are no more than twenty?" The LORD answered, "I will not destroy it, for the sake of the twenty." But he still persisted: "Please, let not my Lord grow angry if I speak up this last time. What if there are at least ten there?" He replied, "For the sake of those ten, I will not destroy it."


## **CREED**






