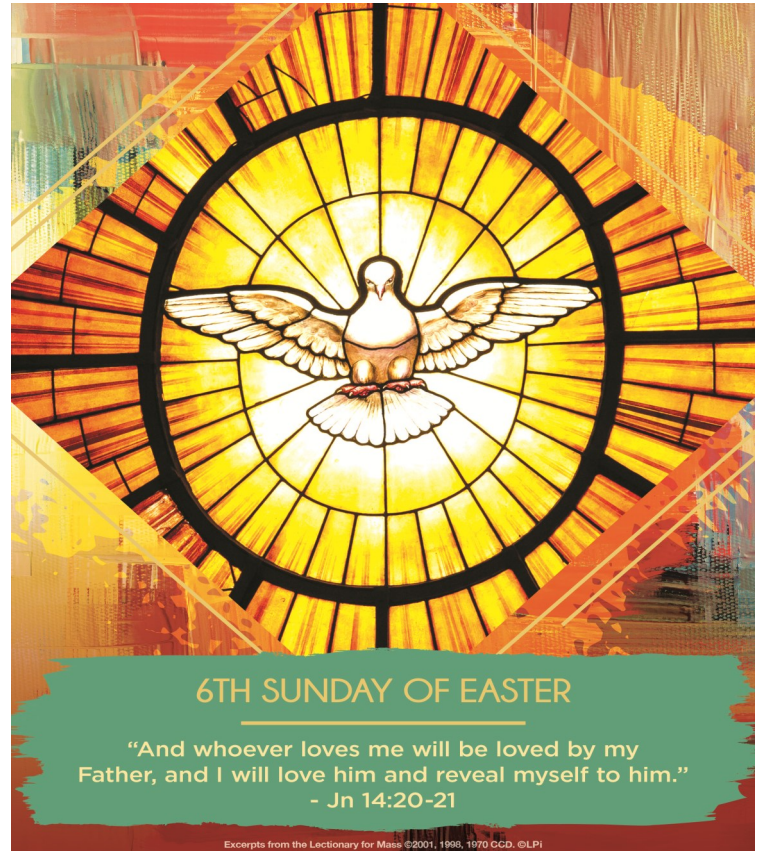

## PASTOR'S NOTES

What loving father or mother would tear up a drawing their child made with love? None would. That is how we should approach our Heavenly Father in prayer. We cannot impress Him with accomplishments—everything we have is already His gift—but we can give Him something simple: a drawing made with love. Think of how you made gifts as a child for your mom, dad, or grandparents when you had no money. That is the posture we bring to God. It means paying attention to the opportunities we are given each day to love others and then offering those moments back to the Father in prayer. A quiet conversation, five minutes spent really listening to someone who has no one to listen to them, a small word of encouragement—these are our drawings. I often forget this. Moments of charity come and go, and I miss the chance to embrace them and offer them back to God at the end of the day. Yet the small acts the Holy Spirit places in our path are exactly that: little drawings we can make for our Father. This takes attention and discernment, not just noticing the loud or obvious needs, but the quiet ones—the person who does not ask for much, the one easily overlooked. See them as a real brother or sister in Christ and let them know in simple ways, “I see you; you matter.” Then bring those moments to prayer and say, “Father, I made this for You today.”

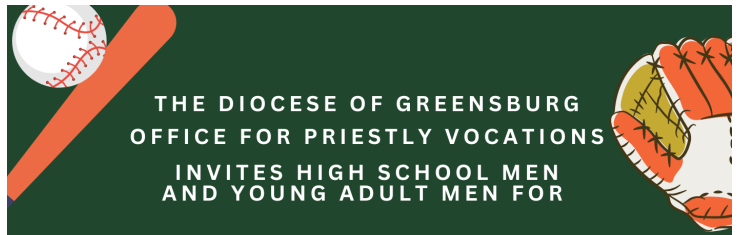

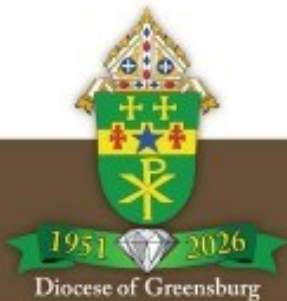

2026 Diocesan Lenten Appeal update as of May 5, 2026

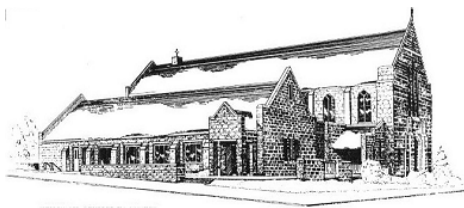
