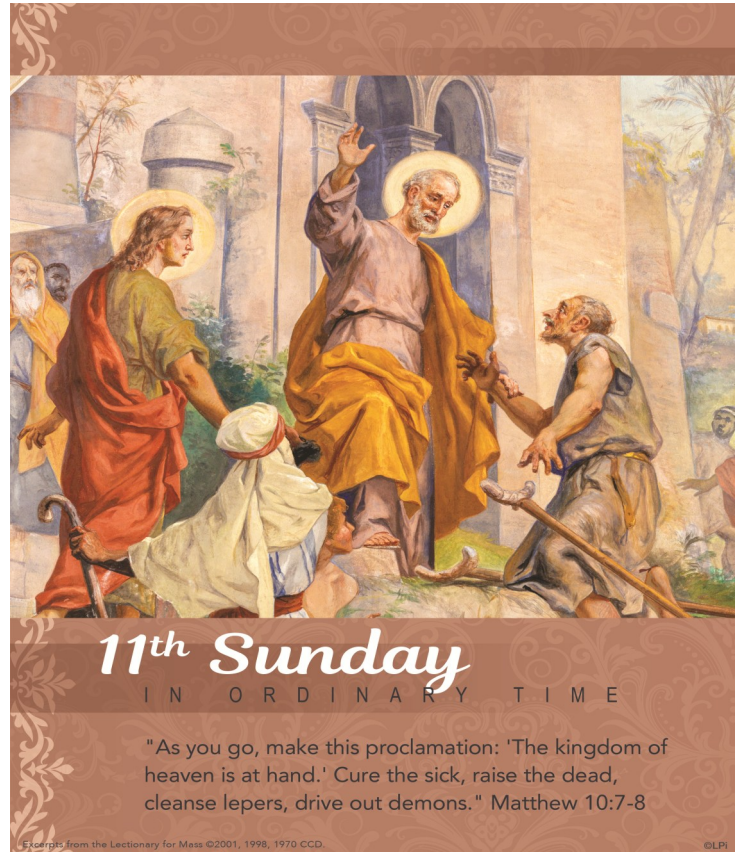

PASTOR'S NOTES

Ask yourself this question today; "Do I tell God the Father, God the Son, and God the Holy Spirit each these three words daily? = I Love You!" I will be the first to admit right here that I had not been saying that for quite some time. I didn't realize that wasn't part of my prayer life. All of the other good ingredients were there: The Liturgy of the Hours, daily Mass, a daily rosary and divine mercy chaplet; but not those three powerful words!

Recently, I was prompted to remember who my God is and repent of all the false ideas I had let grow in my heart about God. False ideas creep up all the time for anyone who seeks to grow in holiness. What are the false ideas? -That God is demanding something I couldn't achieve (or) placing undo spiritual burdens on me. These false ideas come not from the Holy One (but) from the evil one! Reject those ideas as swiftly as your sins. You and I can never repay our Lord Jesus Christ for what He has done for us and that's the whole point of His passion (we can't do it-But He can). That's why the Law was fulfilled in Christ and a new Covenant was given by Him in His most precious Body and Blood. Let's make a commitment today if you find yourself trapped in false assumptions about how to please your Lord. Tell the Holy Trinity ..."I Love You" every day and your prayer life will improve. Don't treat that as an afterthought to the rest of the good prayers you might already offer. Treat these words as foundational and work on them! Our Father gave us a free will so that we may choose to love Him in return. (and) there is no better life available than that!

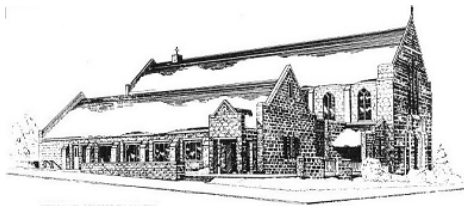

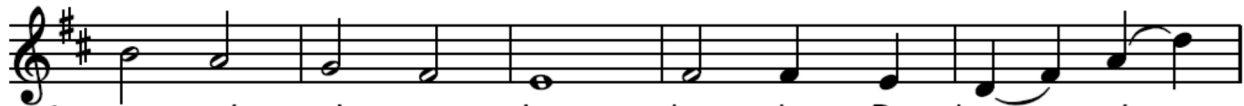

GOSPEL READING

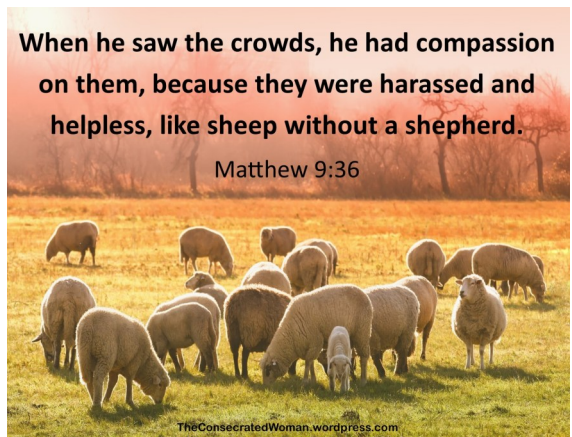
Matthew 9:36-10:8

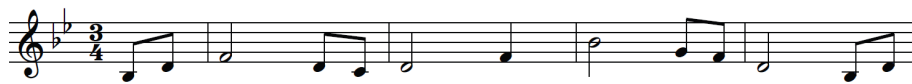




