# PASTOR'S NOTES

Last Sunday, Matthew's Gospel *re-presented* the Twelve Apostles by name (Matthew 10:2-4). After the betrayal of Judas, Matthias was chosen to take his place among the Twelve (Acts 1:23-26). Can you name all Twelve Apostles faster than your favorite modern Saints? One simple way to become familiar with the Apostles is to pray with a Scripture verse about each Apostle. Have you ever played the trivia game where just a few seconds of a song is played, and you have to guess the Song? This is kind of like that using a short clip from the Gospels involving each Apostle! Although this bulletin isn't a trivia game-it may help you win one someday! But at the very least, I hope it helps you get to know the Apostles of Jesus Christ!

**Simon Peter** – John 6:68-69

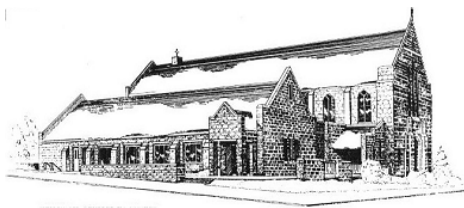


