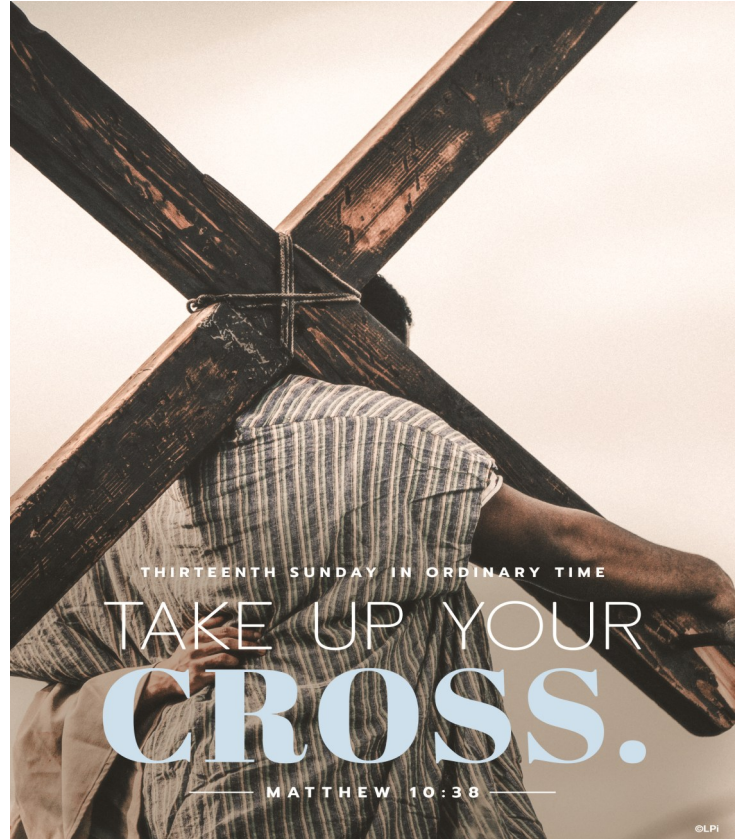

PASTOR'S NOTES

One of the great challenges we face as Catholics is turning away from pride and embracing humility. I admit that pride is one of those things I often overlook in my own life. It does not always seem visible in my day. It does not always come to mind during times of reflection in prayer. Yet, pride can take many forms, and one of the enemy's most effective tactics is to tempt us with a prideful mentality that is difficult to recognize.

Most of us think of pride as being overly confident, self-centered, or believing ourselves better than others. That is one form of pride, and perhaps the most visible form. But there are many others. Pride can certainly appear as self-pity or as a lack of confidence in Christ. But one thing is clear- It always reveals itself by a turning inward, an unwillingness to trust the Lord enough to be vulnerable, charitable, or generous.

A good place to begin is by examining our natural tendencies. Are you an introvert or an extrovert? Do you struggle with confidence, or do you find yourself overly confident? The goal is not to become someone else. The goal is to grow from where you are. The way I need to pray about humility and work on it likely will be a little different from the way you do, but as Catholics we all share the same destination: becoming more Christlike (and what we focus on tends to grow)

Jesus says: *"Whoever loves father or mother more than me is not worthy of me... and whoever does not take up his cross and follow after me is not worthy of me. Whoever finds his life will lose it, and whoever loses his life for my sake will find it."*

These words penetrate the barrier of who I think I ought to be and remind me that every good thing comes from God. Scripture is not calling us to love less. Quite the opposite. My love for father, mother, brother, sister, and neighbor grows only when I humble myself before the Lord and before others each day. That is what it means to lose my life so that I may find it. It is not a rejection of the gift of life God has given me. Rather, it is the rejection of self-preservation rooted in pride. It is the recognition that the Lord who gave me life, who gave me faith, and who calls me forward in the spiritual life is trustworthy.

At its heart, rejecting my own pride means growing in trust of the One who is trustworthy. That trust is built through prayer. It grows when we practice restraint from what harms us and embrace what is good each day. Little by little, humility grows, pride loses its hold, and we become more capable of following Christ wherever He leads. May we all grow in humility today!
