PASTOR'S NOTES

The more time you spend with God-the more time the Holy Spirit will spend in assisting with clarity for your life's problems. Makes sense right? Why would I expect God to solve my problems if He is the last part of my day or the least important part of my day?

I think what keeps most of us away from engaging with our Lord more regularly is not Laziness but a lack of trust. We let the enemy's quiet promptings win - convincing us that God will not help...and what's worse ... that He will scold us if we try harder in prayer. Let's reject that Lie. The first thing to do is this; measure your daily routine. What does it look like? Now just add 30 minutes in Church outside of Mass time... just sitting. Don't try to come up with what you *have* to say to God for prayer or you will feel defeated before you begin-just think about things in front of Him in the Tabernacle. (The same things you would think about anyway. Just sit and think with your Lord, regularly! Make this a daily habit and I promise you things will get better for you. They will get better in accord with God's Will-but it won't be punishment. It will be undeniably good, trust me. You might be in the small percentage of people reading this article who already spend alot of time in Church with God. If so, then great! High Five to you from me! For the majority reading this, I offer this to you as real advice that I need to hear myself often and I know to be true. Now, If only there was a Church around here that was always open for prayer so I could come in any time to sit with my Lord...
