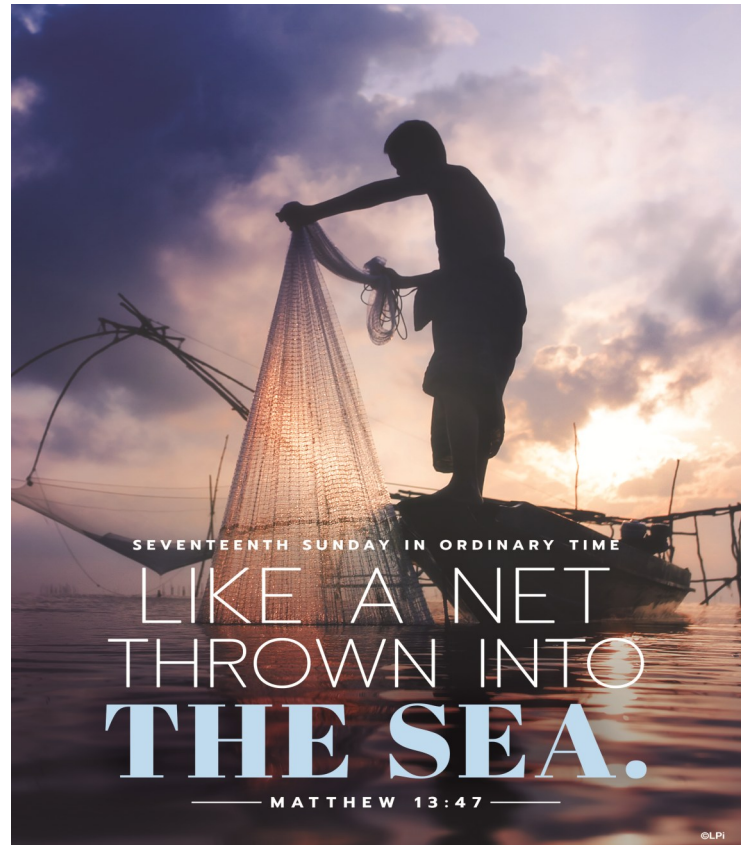

PASTOR'S NOTES

"Follow the momentum" is a phrase I often return too in the spiritual life.

We know the ordinary means God has given us to grow in holiness: daily prayer, regular enough confession, Mass on Sundays and Holy Days, and a sincere effort to try and live according to God's will. That clarity is a gift. We don't have to reinvent the Catholic life.

Still, there are times when we are doing those things faithfully, yet God seems distant. Our prayers feel unanswered, and we wonder what we're doing wrong. Many faithful Catholics have experienced this for centuries. It's not a new issue. It's part of taking the spiritual life seriously.

Sometimes a lack of peace is a call to repentance for some things we *are* doing wrong. That's the Holy Spirit's gift of chastisement; Withdrawing His favor so that we turn back to Him. But other times, we are sincerely striving to follow the Lord and still cannot understand His silence. While there is no simple explanation, one thing remains true: God is trustworthy, even when His presence is not obvious.

When those seasons come, I remind myself to **follow the momentum**. I Ask: *Am I doing what God has already made clear in the momentum of my prayer life?* If so, I keep going. That also requires honest discernment. Are my choices flowing from prayer, or from pride, fear, anger, or self-will? There is peace in knowing that, to the best of our ability, we are following the Lord as He has led us in the momentum of prayer. We may not have every answer, but we can keep walking faithfully, trusting that He will provide the clarity we need for the next step.

Follow the momentum: But, make sure that momentum has come from silent prayer, not self-will. How do I know the difference? The more time you spend with God in quiet prayer, the more time He will spend in your very problems. The less time you spend well ...the opposite is likely true. I give you this from my own experience and the witness of many holier Catholics who have gone before me. Spend time with your God every day!
