

ChristLife provides an effective evangelization video-based program that some have described as a Catholic alpha. It assumes nothing about a person's level of knowledge, introduction you to the purpose of life and especially life in Christ. You start with basic kerygma. It evangelizes and the course hosts function more as facilitators than leaders or catechists. 


GRADUATING SENIORS


