"Unless I see... I will not believe."

Last Sunday, I was with a few friends for dinner. One of my friends brought her little sister and her niece over for the gathering. Her little sister was seven, and her niece was five. The two of them asked me, "Who are you?" and before I could answer the question, one of my friends jumped in and said, "He's a nobody." Well, the two little girls said, "Hey, Mister Nobody." The aunt said to her niece, "That's Fr. Joe. He's a priest." At this point, the two girls' eyes widen, and they both responded with "Nuh-uh! That's impossible!" I asked them, "What's impossible about that?"

"You're in a t-shirt and beach shorts!"

"What's wrong with that?"

"You *can't* be a priest!"

"Sure, I can. I'll show you." I walked over to my backpack and pulled out my clerical shirt and pulled it over my head, then I put the Roman collar on, and they were both in utter disbelief.

"Are you the priest at St. Jude?" they asked.

"No, I live in Donaldsonville."

"Where's that?"

My other friend jumped in again, "That's nowhere, girls."

"You have to come visit one day, girls. It's a peaceful, magical place with no traffic!"

(Let's just say that everyone who was around were just dying laughing at this point.)


How often are we like these two little girls who doubt what they were being told until we see? It's the very moment that when we witness what we have seen that we believe. But that's not the whole picture. A week later, today on the second Sunday after the Resurrection, Divine Mercy Sunday, Thomas is with the other Apostles, still locked inside their fears and doubts. Jesus comes through those locked doors once again, and wishes them peace. And then what does he do? Right after he greets the whole group, his very next words are for Thomas: *Touch my wounds, Thomas; believe in me!*

What look do you think was in Jesus' eyes at that point? I think he was smiling. He was glad to oblige Thomas' stubborn request. He wasn't offended by the Apostle's hesitation and resistance, he was just eager to get his faith back. And Thomas sees this, and he sees that Christ humbly lowers himself to Thomas' level, letting him touch him, letting him feel Christ's real, physical presence. And Thomas falls on his knees and is the first Apostle to proclaim his faith in Christ's divinity, calling him "My Lord and my God", the very titles given to God throughout the whole Old Testament.

We are all Doubting Thomases.

We all resist God's action in our lives in one way or another, get mad at him, don't trust him, rebel against him.

And it is precisely in those moments and those corners of our lives where Jesus wants to show off his boundless mercy, come down to our level, and win back our faith.



Divine Mercy Sunday

April 23, 2017

What graces are available on Divine Mercy Sunday and how do we receive them?

In her Diary, St. Faustina records a special promise given to her by Jesus. He told her to communicate it to the whole world:

- I want to grant a complete pardon to the souls that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion on the Feast of My mercy (1109).
- Whoever approaches the Fountain of Life on this day will be granted complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (300).
- The soul that will go to Confession and receive Holy Communion will obtain complete forgiveness of sins and punishment (699).

To receive these graces, **the only condition is to receive Holy Communion worthily on Divine Mercy Sunday (or the Vigil celebration) by making a good confession beforehand** and staying in the state of grace and trusting in His Divine Mercy.

By these conditions, our Lord is emphasizing the value of confession and Holy Communion as miracles of mercy. The Eucharist is Jesus, Himself, the Living God, longing to pour Himself as Mercy into our hearts.

In addition, our Lord says through St. Faustina that we are to **perform acts of mercy**:

"Yes, the first Sunday after Easter is the Feast of Mercy, but there must also be acts of mercy" (742).

"The graces of My mercy are drawn by means of one vessel only, and that is trust. The more a soul trusts, the more it will receive" (1578).

The worthy reception of the Eucharist on Divine Mercy Sunday is sufficient to obtain the extraordinary graces promised by Jesus. A plenary indulgence, obtained by fulfilling the usual conditions, also is available.

Roots of Faith Play & Special Choir

At the Saturday (April 22) Vigil mass, we are treated to a very special music sung by 40 piece choir members composed of more than six different parishes in our area. The same choir will sing at the **"Roots of Faith" Play on April 28 and 30th at 7PM** held at Ascension Catholic High School.

"Roots of Faith" is a play about the founding of Ascension Catholic School with a cast of characters, including Sr. Loretta Gettemeier, Brother Eldon Crifasi, Brother Carl Bouchereau, Sisters of the Holy Family, Fr. Joe Vu, and many of our prominent alumni as well as students making up a cast of 100. The play will be preceded by a choral Concert Of Early American Music sung by a choir made up of singers from 6 Church parishes. Tickets can be purchased at the ACHS office or at the door.


