## Faith Formation Announcements

Families must register each year. We do not automatically carry a student from one school year to another.

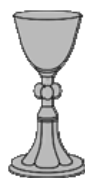
The fee is **\$70** for each child for each school year. A fourth child is only \$30. A family may make a **down payment** of \$30 for one child or \$50 for the family of children.

We need a baptism certificate for each child registering for the first Communion program.

**Confirmation 2** is **\$130** for the school year. Confirmation 2 has a list of requirements before registering for the Confirmation 2 year. Contact the Youth Apostolate Coordinator for more information.
