STRENGTHENED BY THE BREAD OF LIFE

Today we resume the "Bread of Life" discourse from John's Gospel that began two weeks ago. He makes reference to the Jews' ancestors who ate manna in the desert. These days we would think primarily of Israel wandering in the desert, but faithful Jews would also have known the story of Elijah that we hear today. Strengthened by food and drink in the desert, the angel of the Lord sends him on his forty-day and forty-night journey (the biblical number for a preparation time). Like the food given to Elijah in the desert, Jesus tells his listeners that he is bread for the life of the world. It is very important that we not stop listening to Jesus after his promise of eternal life—a marvelous promise, but this "reward" is not the only reason we feast on the Bread of Life. We also come to the table to be made strong for the journey of mission, that the whole world might have life in the fullness of Christ. Faith Formation Announcements

Registration for the 2018-19 Faith Formation year **continues through September 5**. There is no registration after September 5. Classes begin September 9 and 10.



Registration takes place in-person in the faith formation offices. We do not accept emailed or mailed registrations.

Faith Formation **office hours** during Registration are on Mondays through Thursdays 9 AM - 4 PM and Monday and Tuesday evenings from 6 PM – 8:30 PM.

Families must register each year. We do not automatically carry a student from one school year to another.

The fee is **\$70** for each child for each school year. A fourth child is only \$30. A family may make a **down payment** of \$30 for one child or \$50 for the family of children.

We need a baptism certificate for each child registering for the first Communion program. **Confirmation 2** is **\$130** for the school year. Confirmation 2 has a list of requirements before registering for the Confirmation 2 year. Contact the Youth Apostolate Coordinator for more information.

There are two Sunday Registration periods: Sunday, **August 19**, 11 AM - 3 PM, and Sunday, **August 26**, 11 AM - 3 PM. This registration is also in the faith formation offices.
