The Outreach Line operates from 8:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. daily Monday through Friday. A trained mental health professional responds to the line. ST. HILARY MAUSOLEUM

In order to keep our mausoleum orderly we ask that everyone follows these rules concerning placement of flowers and vases on the inside and outside corridors of the mausoleum. There are **NO** containers of any type (vases, pots, glass, etc.) permitted on the floors of the mausoleum. This causes staining and is in the way of workers when the mausoleum is cleaned. These containers are in the way when burials are made in higher level and unfair to Level A owners if containers are put in front of their door for Level B - F. These rules need to be followed for insurance reasons also. Flowers, statues and other items are only allowed at funeral time and will be removed the following week. **Only vases on crypt doors will be allowed.** These rules are from the **Office of Cemeteries** and have been in effect since 1987. We will be enforcing these rules as we have received several complaints as to the cleanliness of our mausoleum. In order to keep it clean we must comply with these rules. You will have **two weeks to remove any containers** from the floors and if they are not removed by you, then we will be forced to remove them and dispose of them. These rules need to be followed and will benefit everyone. Thank you in advance for your cooperation.
