John 17:11b-19

Consecrate them in the truth. Your word is truth.

As you sent me into the world, so I send them into the world."

Disciple means "one who follows." The disciples followed Jesus. They chose to follow him because of his words and deeds, because his deeds were consistent with his words. His words were true because his words were God's words. He showed them his love for others and then told them that God's love is more that we can know or imagine. He taught them that as the Father loves them, they must love one another.
