May 24, 2015 - Pentecost Sunday John 20:19-23

"When the Advocate comes, he will testify to the me. And you will also testify, because you have been with me from the beginning."

Aware that the Jewish and Roman leaders wanted to silence him, Jesus tried to assure his disciples at the Last Supper that he would not abandon them, and that the Advocate, the Spirit of Truth, would always be with them. The disciples would have been comforted by his words, particularly because he noted that they had been with him from the beginning. In the Garden of Gethsemane the betrayal and murder of Jesus begins to unfold and the disciples loose confidence in the Advocate and seem to question the benefit of having been with Jesus from the beginning. It is not until Pentecost [fifty days] after Jesus rose from the dead that the disciples become aware that the Advocate, the Spirit of Truth, was with them and they had the courage to go into the world to proclaim the Truth. We were baptized in the name of the Father, Son and Holy Spirit and received that Advocate, the Spirit of Truth, at our Confirmation.
