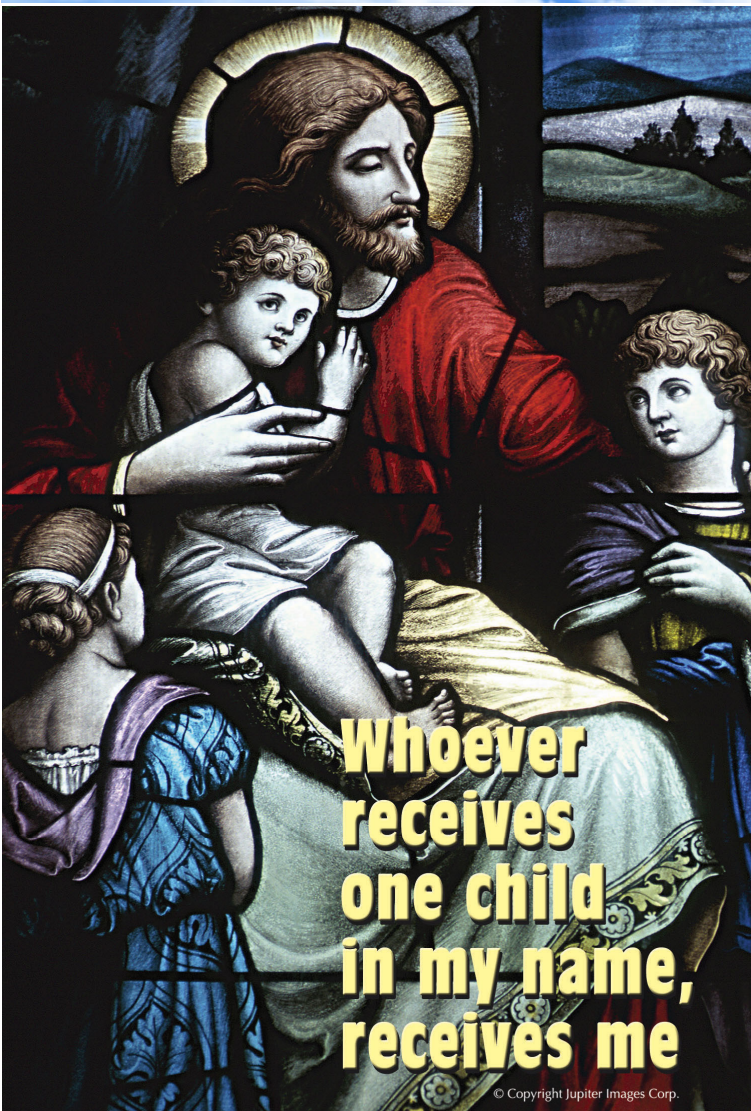

A Letter from Father Bill Leser
Dated September 7, 2015

Dear Father Jim and Parishioners,

I got your surprise container filled with pages and pages of wishes and prayers and notes from so many. I am truly very deeply touched by your concern and heartfelt kindness!

I was the road here and there across our great country from Friday, June 27, until Sunday, August 23, when I had to come home early for medical appointments. Met many wonderful people across our nation. Did wonder about a few folks sanity in Phoenix as it was already 107 degrees my last Sunday there at 10:50 am before celebrating my last Holy Mass there, and the hottest part of the day is not until 4:00 pm.

After getting back home here in Northridge, I had a number of medical appointments. With my Urologist-Cancer doctor as I was still being wiped out by the infection that overtook me after my 18 prostate biopsies on July 28 before going up to the high country. In fact, I am still taking medication for that infection.

Then on August 26 I had my appointment with my dermatologist who removed several small cells with nitrogen, and one growth at the corner of my right eye close to my nose. That was removed by burning it, which also affected my right eye. There were three (3) blast from that flame. I had to keep my eye open or my right eyelashes and eye lid could've been burnt too. Am still taking an antibiotic salve for that surgery and its resulting infection. A layer of membrane came off during last week. See that doc again tomorrow at 1:00 om for biopsy results of that eye growth.

In addition, I saw my nose and throat specialist, who removed part of the growth in my right nostril. It went too far up to remove the whole growth in her office, as she will need to totally have me under a stronger medication to do that. As it was, those six (6) shots of pain medication in the nose were some of the most painful needles ever stuck into me. But once my nose finally was sedated, all was fine. Will get the result on that biopsy tomorrow too. So we'll see what happens tomorrow.

Surgery to remove the cancer tumor in my left kidney takes place after I get back from the Annual Canon Law Society Meeting in Pittsburgh, PA in October. I am also having a MRI tomorrow morning at 7:00 am at Cedar-Sinai Hospital for that upcoming surgery. Tomorrow will be one very busy day.

Last week, the Maronite Bishop asked me to teach a class in canon law at the Los Angeles Archdiocesan Seminary in Camarillo — where I went to school — to the three Maronite Seminarians who are studying there for the Maronite Catholic Eparchy of Our Lady of Lebanon Los Angeles. They will be studying Latin Canon Law with all the Latin Seminarians, so I must teach them about Eastern Canon Law, especially where it is difficult. Mostly as regards the Sacred Mysteries (the Holy Mass and the Sacraments), Penal Law, and a few other things.

O yes! I had to get a new cell phone, as my last cell really gave up its ghost last week. One of the two sim cards totally sort of blew-up while I was driving home from Mono County.

I would appreciate a few prayers for all these infections I am having. Thanks! Some of these have been more painful than my upcoming cancer surgery to remove the kidney tumor. Right now I have this overwhelming urge to want to scratch my right eye. But I must stop myself again and again. Can't touch my eye, or I could spread that infection. Guess it must be healing.

God bless! May He reward you and you're a hundredfold for your many kindnesses.

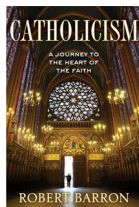
Catholicism Series

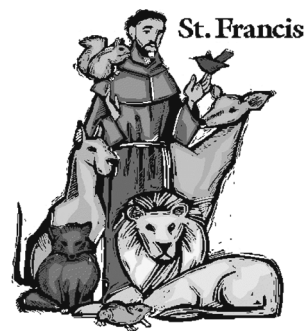

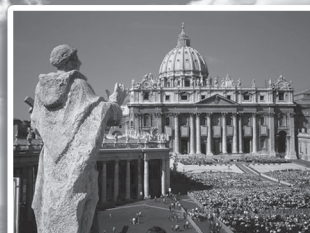

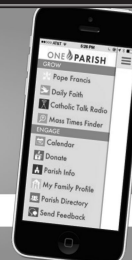
