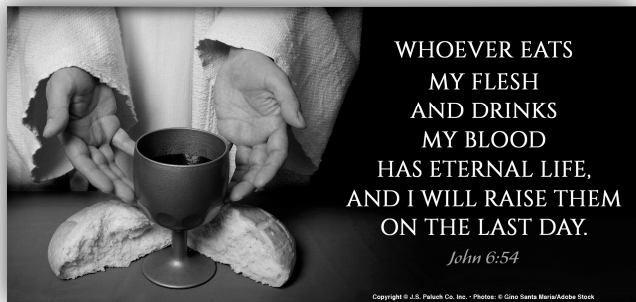

FAITH FORMATION REGISTRATION

REGISTRATION OPEN

Registration for Confirmation, Family Faith, Special Needs and Junior High Ministry is now open and available online.



Sign up for classes in the faith formation/confirmation office or online on the parish website. Returning students must register each year. **Registration is not automatic for returning students.**

- **Confirmation:** Year 1/2: Include class nights, youth nights and a retreat each year
- **Family Faith:** Grades 1-6 Attend monthly meetings as a family, with follow up work at home
- **Junior High Ministry:** 7th and 8th - Every Wednesday, service projects, game night and classes
- **Special Needs:** Monthly on Sundays

The Adult Confirmation Preparation classes are for parishioners who are out of high school and who have been baptized and received First Communion, but who have yet to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Announcing another great Back-to-School Collection which will help 817 children prepare for the school year! We were appreciative to receive 300 backpacks from Outdoor Rec Group in L.A. once again. The remaining school supplies and backpacks were donated by our parishioners and the use of a grant from Ventura County Community Foundation secured by a generous donor. The items were donated to Catholic Charities Ventura and Moorpark, Lutheran Social Services, Many Mansions, Project Understanding, MICOP, Oxnard Rescue Mission, Heart 2 Heart, Homeless Services, and a few "friends of the parish" with significant needs. The cash donations of \$2,329 will be used to finance the supplies purchased for the five organizations who were in need of their supplies for those who began school early.



The project went smoothly and wrapped up on Sunday night rather than waiting until our usual Tuesday packing night.

Thank you to all team leaders and volunteers who pulled this significant project together, all donors, and volunteers who delivered. It's always inspiring to see so many hands and feet reaching out to the community in need. Thank you! Happy end of summer!

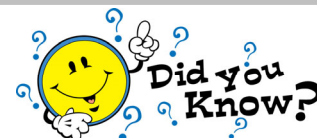

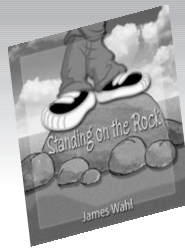

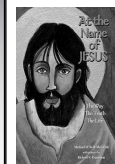
