



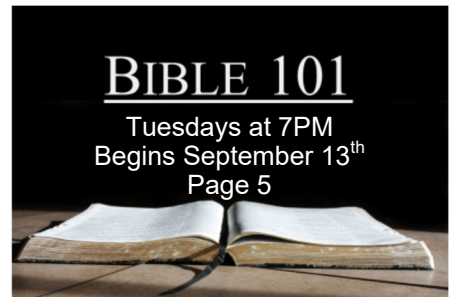

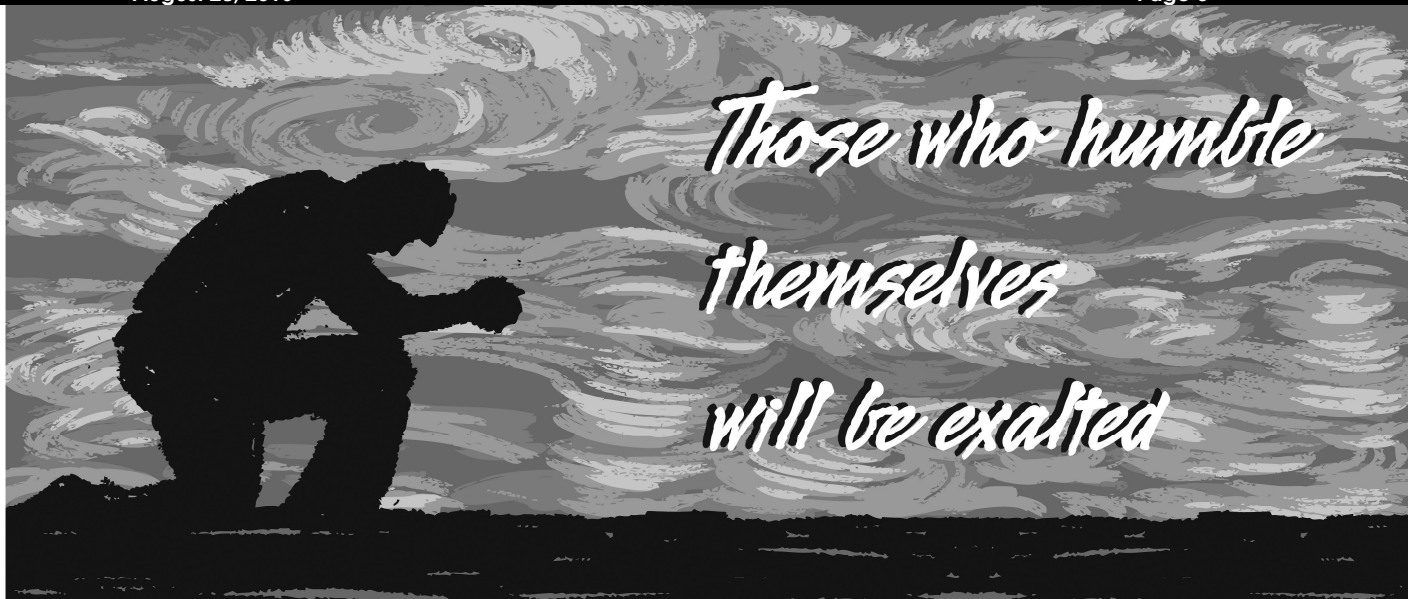

### August 28, 2016 • Twenty-second Sunday in Ordinary Time

Today's Gospel relates the story of a rich Pharisee who has invited Jesus to his home for a banquet. Jesus teaches him and his guests a lesson in humility. Take the lowest place and do not exalt yourself. "Then you will enjoy the esteem of your companions at the table." We see in the papers stories about lavish banquets, "fund-raisers" for good causes. Some of these are little more than the social life of the rich, raising a small percentage of their cost for the poor and needy, and giving glory to their organizers. People pay hundreds of dollars per person to attend these functions, tens of thousands on gowns and clothing of every kind. Often they include auctions of donated, extravagant trips, the use of yachts and private planes that go for donations of tens of thousands of dollars. These events often raise fifty to one hundred thousand dollars for the cause, while costing a million dollars to stage and attend. To this, Jesus might say, "When you hold a lunch or a dinner, do not invite your friends or your brothers or your relatives or your wealthy neighbors, in case they may invite you back and you have repayment."

## HUMILITY

Contrast this with the people who work hard to feed the hungry at food banks, minister to the homeless and lonely at lunches and dinners at church halls, and prepare lunches to be distributed to the homeless. These actions get no coverage in the society sections of newspapers, yet they are more valuable to God than all the lavish banquets of the rich. "When you hold a banquet, invite the poor, the crippled, the lame, the blind; blessed indeed will you be because of their inability to repay you. For you will be repaid at the resurrection of the righteous."

### HUMILITY

Have you ever been in a group of people--maybe on a tour, at a social gathering, or at church--and discovered that you have just been talking with a well-known author, corporate CEO, great scholar, or politician? Your first thought is the hope that you didn't say anything to embarrass yourself; but your second thought is how much they seemed like such "regular" folks. What is it that makes people seem so "regular"? Today's readings give us a clue when they stress the importance of humility.

It is so hard for us not to tell the first person who will listen how busy we are, how hard we work, how much money we donate, and how important our job titles are. We think these accolades make a difference to people, and if we don't tell them, how will they ever know? But if our actions demonstrate our values, people will recognize our worth on their own. The words of Jesus show us how much better it is to let someone else recognize our worth than to be embarrassed because someone did not.

But reach out with the invitation now. Make that call now. E-mail me. Let's talk. Let's pray.

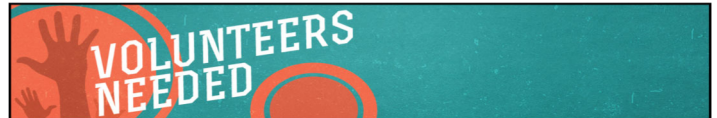

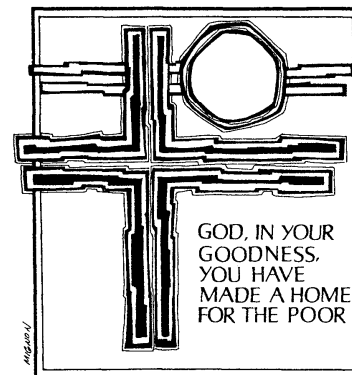

**food collection**

Eight months each year food is collected from parishioners and donated to agencies serving food-insecure families. Participating parishioners are asked to donate twice each year in their area. You can also donate every month.

**How does the food collection work?** Our parish has been divided into four geographical areas which are asked TWO times a year for a bag of groceries. The food is picked up on the third Saturday of the month and brought to the Church parking lot for sorting and boxing before being picked up by specified service agencies for distribution to needy families.

**Who gets the food?** Catholic Charities, Dolores Mission, St. Vincent de Paul, Impacto/Underwing, Lighthouse Shelter for Women and Children, and Care and Share are regular recipients. The converted dollar donations are used to help more than 20 other organizations.

**How can I help?** You can help by donating, sorting, packing and loading food to be donated to agencies serving homeless and low-income families or individuals. Also, there is opportunity to make reminder phone calls and to pick up food at parishioner's homes.
