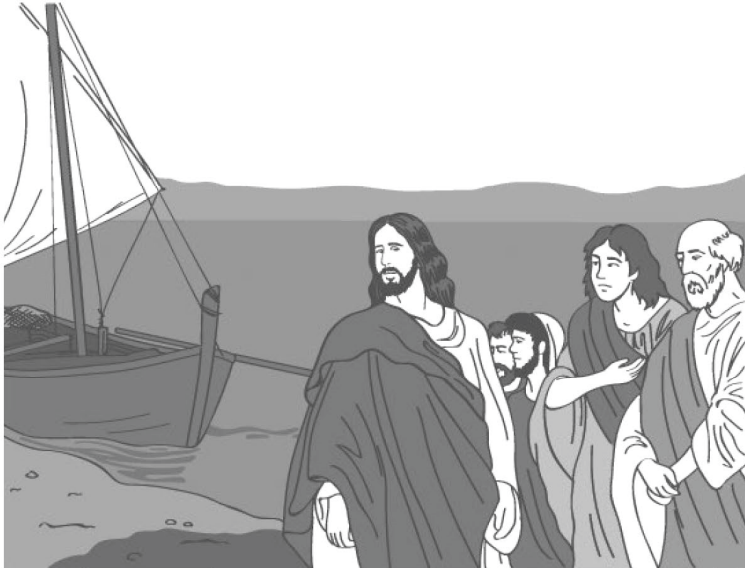

SIXTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME

In today's first reading, we hear through the prophet Jeremiah that God understands the need of the people for shepherds who will lead them to a place of spiritual depth and peace. In the Letter to the Ephesians, we hear that this desire that the people find peace in right relationship with God is for everyone. Jesus, the Good Shepherd, leads the disciples to a deserted place to rest. They had just returned from their first time of mission, and Jesus understands that they need time away with him, to share their experiences and questions, and to find refreshment of body and spirit. Yet Jesus also recognizes the needs of the crowds who follow them to that deserted place. He knows that he is the peace for which they long.

SABBATH REST

Sabbath. We hear the word, and many think of the obligation to attend Sunday Mass. Today, we hear Jesus say to the disciples, 'Come away to a deserted place and rest a while.' This is the true spirit of sabbath--to take time away, to worship God, participate in Eucharist, to be refreshed in body, mind, and spirit. Thought of in this way, sabbath is not an obligation but a privilege, a gift rather than a burden. Making sabbath begins with a commitment to put God first. That is what the shepherds that Jeremiah called for were to do, to lead the people to be people of and for God. This is what Jesus, the Good Shepherd, leads us to do, and he shows us how to do this. Not only does Jesus take time away for prayer and to "rest a while," he also spends time with the people who need him. In sabbath, we spend time with God, family, our faith community, and friends. And this spending time "with" helps us to re-orient our lives toward what is most important.

FROM SABBATH TO THE REST OF THE WEEK

Taking sabbath to heart has a significant impact on the way in which we live our lives, practically and spiritually. The practical part is evident on the surface. Setting aside time for Sunday Mass, quiet, and time with others requires planning and commitment. There is a practical dimension to the physical and emotional benefits of such time away from the stress and busyness of our daily lives as well. The spiritual impact of sabbath may take a little while to begin to perceive. When we put God first in our lives, everything else falls into place in a different, holier way. We begin to see God's grace in the daily circumstances of our lives, and to grow in understanding of what we are to do and how we are called to act. We know who we are in God's sight, and whose we are, as children of God.

REGISTRATION OPEN

Registration for Confirmation, Family Faith, Special Needs and Junior High Ministry is now open and available online.

- **Confirmation:** Year 1/2: Include class nights, youth nights and a retreat each year
- **Family Faith:** Grades 1-6 Attend monthly meetings as a family, with follow up work at home
- **Junior High Ministry:** 7th and 8th - Every Wednesday, service projects, game night and classes
- **Special Needs:** Monthly on Sundays

Loaves & Fishes Ministry Update

The first month of summer has passed, and Loaves & Fishes Ministry already has lots to report. The needs never stop, and neither do our Loaves and Fishes folks!

1. The Bikes 4 Kids (and adults) ministry delivered 2 trikes and 3 scooters to St. Catherine of Sienna School for their playground. That will make some happy kids for the beginning of the school year. Another bike was delivered to Lutheran Social Services for a client needing transportation to work. Thanks to anyone who donated their bike and to Arthur for delivering! By the way, if you have a bike in your garage not being used, we would love to fix it up and pass it along to someone in need.
2. Gas and food cards were donated to Catholic Charities OASIS for seniors in need.
3. Twelve more start-up kits for pre-teens going into foster care were delivered to Heart 2 Heart. They contained a new outfit, pajamas, underwear, socks, toiletries, snacks and basic school supplies. Thanks to a St. Jude teen for packing those to be delivered.
4. The Baby Day Collection gathered quite a few pieces of gently used baby equipment (3 cribs, 2 strollers, a high chair and a changing table) along with many bags of clothing and boxes of diapers. Thanks to all who participated. Change from the baby bottles continues to be counted.
5. The Women's Interfaith Network group came to St. Jude's to pack 830 bags of food and activities for kids missing free school lunches this summer with St. Jude volunteers. These were delivered to First Five, St. John's Outreach, Catholic Charities, Lutheran Services, Westminster Free Clinic, and Homeless Services for distribution to kids served by their organizations. Thanks to all who donated items, packed and delivered along with our friends from many Conejo Valley house of faith.
6. A team from St. Jude's Confirmation group made and donated 60 care bags from Loaves and Fishes when they served meals to the homeless last week. Thanks for your care and service.

Campus Security Project

Our security program will consist of creating a perimeter using wrought Iron fencing, vehicular gates, and personal gates that will control who is allowed access while school is in session. While school is in session, these gates will be closed. Wrought Iron has been selected as the material of choice for this project due to the fact that it is not easily breached or vandalized. Moreover, it maintains visibility. On weekends, for this busy parish, the fences will be rolled back to allow maximum use of the parish parking lot.

Here are the goals of the security fencing, gate and access control security plan:

- Designating the school grounds as a well-defined, carefully maintained space that deserves respect.
- Further enabling and expanding video surveillance by school staff.
- Modernizing our safety systems and providing more efficiency.
- Limiting access to areas that are not highly visible.
- Restricting entry and exit points to a few easily monitored areas.

To help you visualize the scope of the future project we have put together a site plan and renderings outlining where the new fencing, vehicular gates, and personal gates will be located. We are in the process of obtaining firm bids for the work from several local contractors. This project will be phased over a period of time based on the gracious and kind support of our St. Jude the Apostle Community.

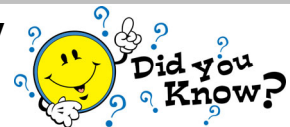

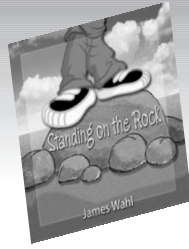

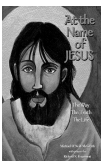
