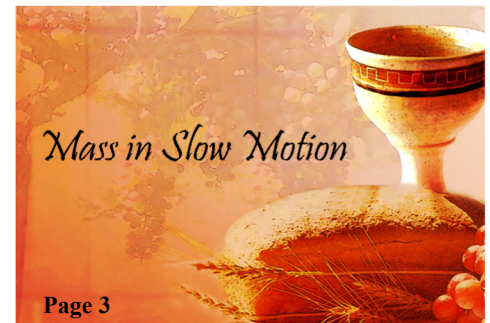


My Dear Parish Family,

Next weekend at all the Masses at St. Jude's we'll have a special opportunity to deepen our prayerful participation in the Mass. We won't be turning the Mass into a class...but we will be punctuating the Mass with brief commentaries that will help us pray-through each particular part of the Mass.

Many of you are well-acquainted with Dr. Paul Ford: a professor at St. John's Seminary who has been a regular speaker at the University here in our area and the annual Religious Education Congress in Anaheim. He has been very active here and around the Conejo Valley in giving workshops and talks and days of recollection that many of us have taken advantage of. Some years ago Dr. Ford compressed a great deal of spiritual direction and hard-won wisdom into a running commentary that he called "The Mass In Slow Motion". We will be incorporating this commentary into all of next weekend's Masses. Don't worry: the Masses won't be significantly longer than they usually are. We won't actually be celebrating the Mass i-n---s-l-o-w---m-o-t-i-o-n. But we will be taking our time and briefly unpacking some of the significance of each part of the perfect prayer that we call the Mass.

One of the ways that we can prepare ourselves to fully participate in the Mass is to regularly pray a prayer of "Daily Offering". At each Mass we are invited to stand alongside Jesus and offer Jesus (and ourselves with Him) to God our Father. While most of us can't come to Mass on a daily basis, we all can and should offer ourselves--every aspect of ourselves--every day to God: for his glory and for his service. You will find below one version of the Daily Offering prayer. Can I please suggest that we all make it a part of our morning prayers between now and next weekend? If you're not used to beginning your morning with prayer, maybe you can tape this prayer to your mirror or your computer screen or your refrigerator door or someplace where you will see it as you begin your day.

In the meantime: Peace in His service,

## ARE YOU INTERESTED IN BECOMING CATHOLIC?



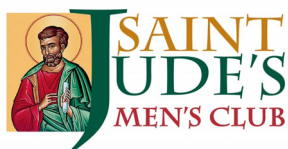

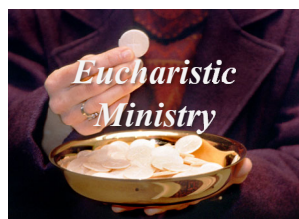
