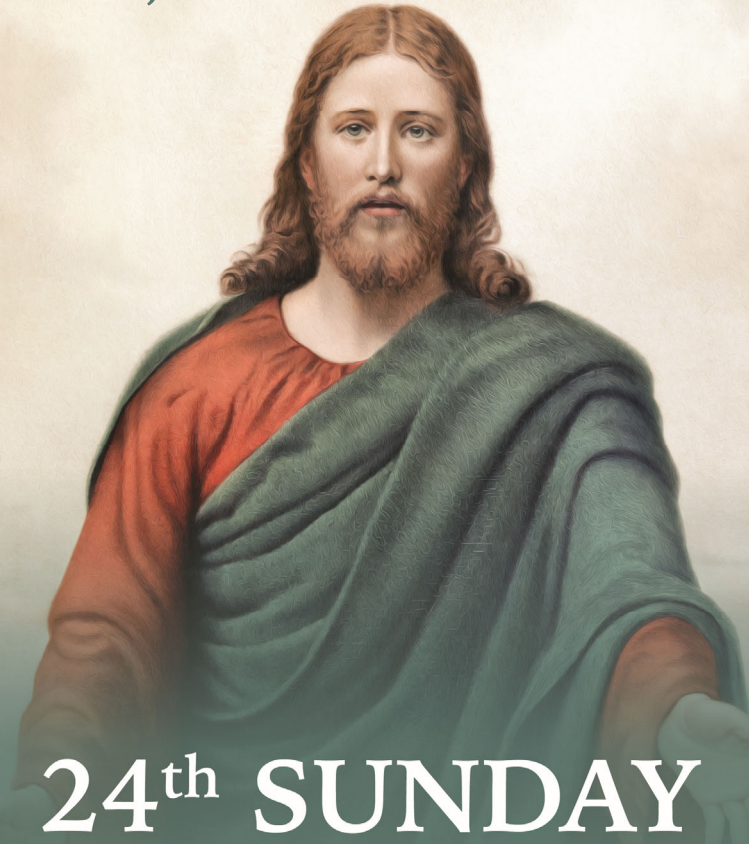

You would then click on the picture of Bishop Barron to go to the Word on Fire digital library. At the end of July, you will get an email or text for the Eucharist Course that Bishop Barron created. REGISTRATION OPEN

Registration for Confirmation, Family Faith, Special Needs and Junior High Ministry is now open and available online.



Sign up for classes in the faith formation/confirmation office or online on the parish website. Returning students must register each year. **Registration is not automatic for returning students.**

- **Confirmation:** Year 1/2: Include class nights, youth nights and a retreat each year
- **Family Faith:** Grades 1-6 Attend monthly meetings as a family, with follow up work at home
- **Junior High Ministry:** 7th and 8th - Every Wednesday, service projects, game night and classes
- **Special Needs:** Monthly on Sundays

ADULT CONFIRMATION

The Adult Confirmation Preparation classes are for parishioners who are out of high school and who have been baptized and received First Communion, but who have yet to receive the Sacrament of Confirmation. Prayer for Catechists

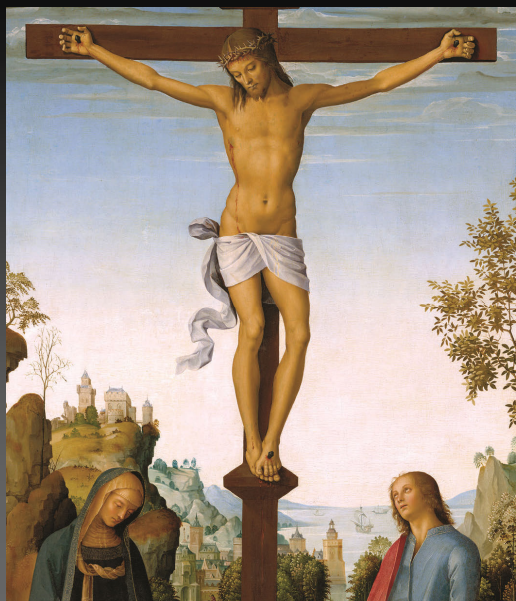

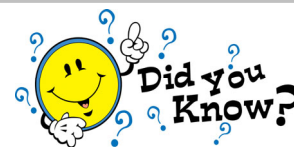

Talk to your teens about handling workplace violence



Many teens will get their first job while still in high school. Building a work ethic is a great and necessary skill, but teens need to be informed to about how best to handle possible workplace violence. Coworkers are not always thoroughly screened, and your teen could face another employee's rage or anger that could possible put them in danger. Talk to your teens about warning signs—short tempers, intimidation, drug use—and about how to remove themselves when they feel unsafe in a situation, and how to report any concerns they have, to a safe adult. We meet on Fridays at 10am in the library. Next meetings: October 12, October 26

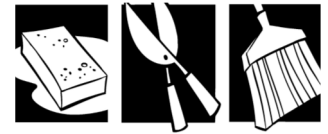

Recyclables are collected year round to provide funds for purchasing items for our local homeless. Recyclables can be placed in containers marked "Recyclables" around the church grounds any time.



WHICH RECYCLABLES CAN I DROP OFF?

ACCEPTED: Please drop off only recyclable bottles and cans (**marked CRV**), aluminum, and glass bottles (except for wine bottles - no redemption value).

Ours is one of over 23,000 Public Square rallies that will be held concurrently at noon (local time), throughout the United States, on Saturday, October 13th.

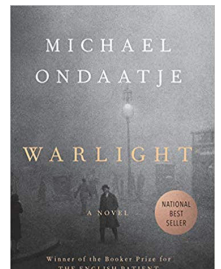

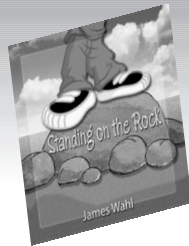

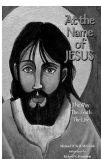
