



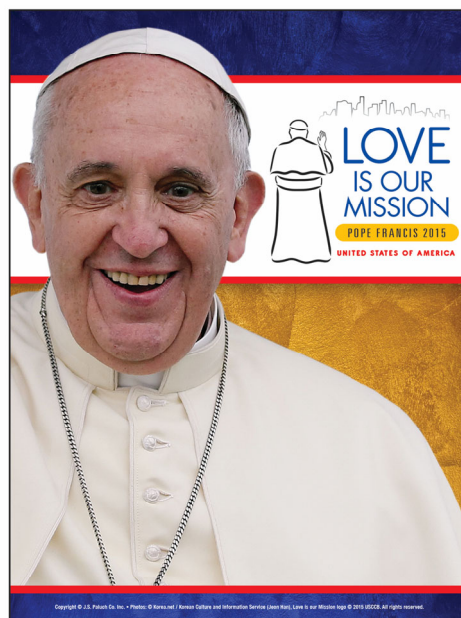

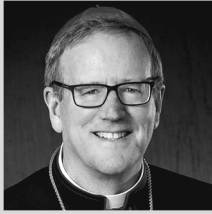

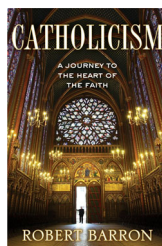
## Catholicism Series

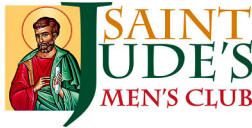

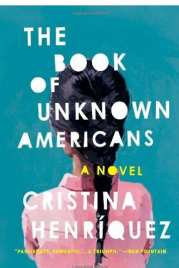

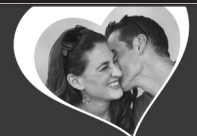
