





### Remembering Father Joseph Laporte 50th Anniversary September 15, 1932– March 13, 1965

Rev. Joseph Laporte, or "Father Joe", was Parochial Vicar at St. Monica Parish and Gate of Heaven Parish from his ordination in 1959 until his early death in 1965 at the age of 32. Fr. Joe was born in Haverhill, but belonged in South Boston. He was ordained by Cardinal Richard Cushing on February 2, 1959 and sent to South Boston to "look after the youth."

A parish history book from St. Monica published in 1980 stated: Father Laporte especially made a tremendous impression on the young. Many remember how he would find youngsters on street corners and listen to their confessions or how he organized a special Devotional Mission for South Boston youths.

Newspaper articles from 1965 have quotes from teenaged parishioners who recalled how much Father Joe had done for them. One said, "He was just always around. I don't think he ever slept." Another said, "Fr. Joe did everything."

Father Laporte was diagnosed with leukemia in 1963. Rather than accept a lighter assignment where he could rest and try to be comfortable, Fr. Laporte told the Cardinal Cushing "Please leave me in South Boston. I would rather wear away working here than rust away doing nothing." For two more years, Fr. Joe continued to work in South Boston with the kids—whether it was playing basketball, handball at the L, or hearing a confession walking on the beach—he guided them on the right path.

Thousands attended his wake at Gate of Heaven Church. He lie in state from 3pm until Midnight and there was a constant stream of parishioners coming to pay their respects. His funeral Mass was standing room only with hundreds standing in the aisles. The Mass was celebrated by his friend auxiliary Bishop of Boston Most Rev. Jeremiah Minihan.

### Letter from Cardinal Richard Cushing praising Fr. Laporte reprinted from a 1964 Bulletin:

are recognized publicly.

In a world which pays small notice to spiritual values, the work of a priest is a matter of little concern. To those who are enriched with the gift of faith, however, it is a blessing which the Lord has sent. For as long as God wills it, the anointed hands of the priest are raised in benediction. His

very presence is a joy to the young, a comfort to the aged. a consolation to the sick and the dying. To the uninstructed he preaches and teaches the truths of eternal life. To the sinner he speaks sorrowful words of kindness, understanding and forgiveness. He is all things to all people, seeking nothing beyond the good of souls and looking towards no one but Christ to Whom he consecrates his energies and his whole

being.

I am pleased to salute Father Laporte on this happy occasion.

He has applied himself diligently and unselfishly to the service of the Church and the care of souls. He is a typical Boston priest who is loved and respected by people because of what he is and what he does.

May God bless, protect and reward him in His own inimitable way.

### DARK-HAIRED WHIRLWIND

On a beautiful fall day in 1954, I encountered for It is alleged to have occurred in a class conducted the first time a six foot one, 195 pound dark - haired whirlwind who introduced himself as "Joe Laporte, from Haverhill." It was noticeable even then that he never walked anywhere. He rushed, And whenever you went with him from one building to another on the Seminary campus, you had the feeling of flight from some speedy, relentless Here was a man in a hurry and if you would call him friend, speed became your constant

Yet if there happened to be a fellow seminarian who injured a foot or was compelled by some physical necessity to walk slowly. Joe Laporte could be seen meandering along with him as though his most pressing problem consisted in placing one foot slowly ahead of the other.

Consideration for and understanding of people were among his most notable characteristics. He was very popular with his classmates and a genuine joy to be with. You left a conversation with Joe

these characteristics to St. Monica's parish in South Boston. I am certain that many a St. Monica parishioner can testify from personal experience to these priestly traits that are so inextricably a part of Father Laporte.

His sense of humor is perhaps best illustrated

by a particularly stern seminary professor. About a week before class this professor had given Father Laporte a book of about 1700 pages to read and then pass on to his classmates. After he scanned this scholarly tome, he tried to give it to several of his confreres but they all avoided him and it. Finally the week ended and the professor asked Father Laporte in class about the book and When Father Joe admitted that its whereabouts. he still had it, the professor thought that he was enjoying it so thoroughly that he didn't want to pass it on and so he asked, "What impressed you most about the work?" And Father Laporte, recalling the 1700 pages he had been trying to unload for several days, answered: "Its weight, Monsignor." The reply of the professor has never been recorded.

While the story may not actually have happened, Father Laporte's sense of humor is real enough as all who have come in contact with him during his years in South Boston can readily testify.


### Focus on the Youth

Father Laporte was well-known for his support of the young adults in South Boston. Many parishioners recall stories of him hearing confession on Carson Beach or following a game of handball at the L Street Bathhouse.

Msgr. John T. Powers, Pastor of Gate of Heaven from 1955-1977 wrote of Fr. Laporte:

Youth then had many interests and, of course, this is true of our own sometimes maligned South Boston young people. Yet whenever we think of South Boston and youth, inevitably there comes to mind a flashing black-clad figure in the midst of them -- our own beloved Father Laporte. Wherever young people gather -- on a corner, at a dance, at a ball game, or Kelly's Landing, wherever they are -- there he is. He cares about them, shares their enthusiasms and their problems~~ and they know it.

Grant, we pray, O Lord, that the soul of your servant Father Joseph Laporte, your priest, whom in this life did you honor with the sacred office, may rejoice in the glory of Heaven for evermore.

Legends about Patrick abound; but truth is best served by our seeing two solid qualities in him: He was humble and he was courageous. The determination to accept suffering and success with equal indifference guided the life of God's instrument for winning most of Ireland for Christ. What distinguishes Patrick



is the durability of his efforts. When one considers the state of Ireland when he began his mission work, the vast extent of his labors (all of Ireland) and how the seeds he planted continued to grow and flourish, one can only admire the kind of man Patrick must have been. The holiness of a person is known only by the fruits of his or her work.

"Christ shield me this day: Christ with me, Christ before me, Christ behind me, Christ in me, Christ beneath me, Christ above me, Christ on my right, Christ on my left, Christ when I lie down, Christ when I arise, Christ in the heart of every person who thinks of me, Christ in the eye that sees me, Christ in the ear that hears me" (from "The Breastplate of St. Patrick").

### Feast of St. Joseph March 19th

The Bible pays Joseph the highest compliment: he was a "just" man. The quality meant a lot more than faithfulness in paying debts. By saying Joseph was "just," the Bible means that he was one who was completely open to all that



 $\operatorname{\mathsf{God}}$  wanted to do for him. He became holy by opening himself totally to  $\operatorname{\mathsf{God}}$  .

The rest we can easily surmise. Think of the kind of love with which he wooed and won Mary, and the depth of the love they shared during their marriage.

"He was chosen by the eternal Father as the trustworthy guardian and protector of his greatest treasures, namely, his divine Son and Mary, Joseph's wife. He carried out this vocation with complete fidelity until at last God called him, saying: 'Good and faithful servant, enter into the joy of your Lord'" (St. Bernardine of Siena).


