# Fr. Michael's Musings



As often happens before the Feast of Christ the King, I think about coronations.

In the coronation

rite for Great Britain, following the anointing, the crown is blessed and then placed upon the head of the new monarch.

This is expected, but what I always find interesting is that the peers of the realm, earls, dukes, etc., all stand carrying crowns in their hands.

As the monarch is crowned, each of them places the crown of their office, or family, upon their heads.

I would imagine this ritual comes from the time when Britain had many kings, but only one High King, and at his coronation, the other kings were crowned as well.

I find this imagery interesting historically, but utterly life-changing spiritually. At your baptism, as you were anointed with the Chrism of the Holy Spirit, the priest or deacon said, "As Christ was anointed priest, prophet and king, so may you live always as a member of his body, sharing everlasting life."

And God placed your crown upon your head. You share in the Kingship of Christ, to bring His Kingdom, "an eternal and universal kingdom, a kingdom of holiness and grace, a kingdom of justice, love and peace," into the world.

As Christ is crowned, so are we.

Do not be afraid, you have been anointed with the Holy Spirit, empowered by love, crowned with the dignity of the Son of God. For the world, you are priest, prophet and king; reign in peace.
