This weekend begins Catholic Schools Week across the nation and in the Hub City.

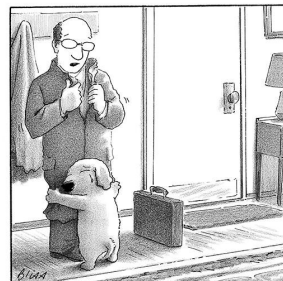
It is a wonderful time for us to pause and reflect on what a blessing and a gift it is to have our school system as a ministry of our parish.
