100 coffeemugs. That was the first assignment that I had in my ceramics studies in college. It seemed like a lot of mugs at the time but that is the

way of the potter, you didn't make something once, you figured out the process so you can make a consistent product whenever you need. It took me about 200 mugs before I was happy with the form, but it was good practice.

So this week when I had to make 21 small drawers for my nail cabinet I had flashbacks to my ceramics days. You do the same motions over and over, establishing a process so you get consistent results. Yet even in this there is variation, the results are consistent, but not perfect. But that is the way of humanity.

We live our lives day in and day out and sometimes it seems like we never quite get it all figured out, and that would be right. We will never get everything right all of the time, perfection rests in God alone, but we are called to keep trying.

This weekend Jesus gives us a parable about following the will of the heavenly Father. We may not always follow as perfectly as we are called, or even as perfectly as we want, but we are called to admit our fault, and keep seeking God's will in our lives. The more we seek His will, the purer He will make our will, maybe not perfect, but consistently drawing closer to God.
