Fr. Michael's Musings



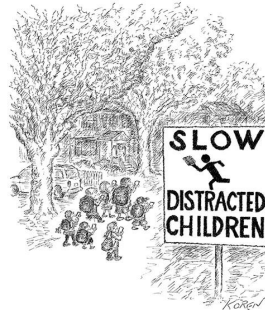
This week affords the Church a wonderful opportunity for fun, reflection and faith.
