Well, it happens every few years, and once again St. Patrick's Day falls on a Friday of Lent.

Bishop Swain has given a dispensation from the need to abstain from meat ONLY IF you are attending a St. Patrick's Day event, celebration or party.


If you are not, then the need to abstain from meat remains in effect.

I always remember how Bishop Dudley, the good Irishman that he was, would be bombarded with requests to dispense from the discipline for St. Patrick's Day. His response was always simple: It would honor Patrick as a Saint far better to keep the discipline of Lent, than to honor him with corned beef.

What makes this beautiful response pertinent for us, is that it is a powerful reminder that we do not perform the disciplines of Lent in isolation, we honor our ancestors, we unite with all the Church. Our fasting and abstaining is a reminder that we are on this journey together.

So, this young Irishman will enjoy his corned beef and cabbage on the 16th of March and on the 17th, as I eat my meatless meals, I will give thanks for my heritage and the faith that was so lovingly passed on to me.

But, of course, I'll still wear green on Friday. There is a limit to what one can be expected to give up.
