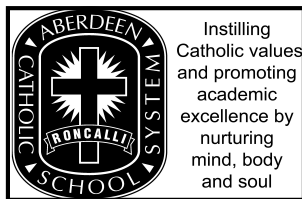

used in the Sacramental life of the Church are blessed and consecrated.

The Oil of Catechumens is used to strengthen those preparing for Baptism.

The Oil of the Sick is used to anoint those who suffer that their suffering might be united to Christ.

The Oil of Sacred Chrism, the oil of the Holy Spirit, consecrated that it might be used in Confirmation, Holy Orders and Baptism
