The numbers in the Sunday collections are dropping and continue to drop...and for the life of me, I cannot figure out why.

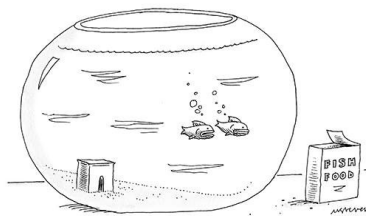
I try to keep the financial talks to a minimum, but it is getting increasingly difficult to get by, pay salaries, keep up the building, pay bills, etc. etc.
