It is always a wonderful blessing to have the Bishop come to celebrate Mass in our parish. This weekend, he comes to celebrate the Sacrament of Confirmation.

I am always struck by the way a Bishop begins the celebration of the Eucharist. While priests say the standard greeting, only Bishops say, "Peace be with you" for the greeting at Mass.


These were the first words the Risen Lord spoke to the Apostles, and the use of these words, at this place in the Mass, reminds us that the Bishop is not just the leader of our diocese, but is the arrival of an Apostle in our midst.

The Bishop represents the unbroken line of succession back to the upper room, to those first Apostles, looking on with fear and trembling as the Risen Lord comes to them and offers them peace.

As we heard last weekend, the Lord then sent them forth...and forth they went, to teach and minister and heal and to choose successors, who chose their successors, and so on, and so on, until Paul Swain was chosen and took his place in that long, beautiful lineage.

We rejoice in Bishop Swain's Apostolic ministry to us and with us. We receive him with abundant joy this weekend as he offers us peace, and may it be with his spirit as well.
