Today we enter into the holiest week of the year, the week that brings meaning to our lives, the week from which all vocations and Sacraments flow.

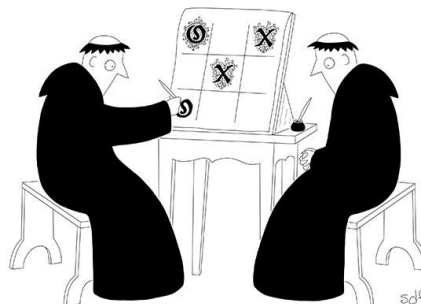
Matrimony, Ordination, Religious Profession, flow from these days; the Sacramental life of the baptized, flows from these days.

Make these days special, meaningful and holy. Embrace the ancient rituals of these Three Days, set the usual and the ordinary aside, and hear the words that begin it all: *We should glory in the Cross of our Lord Jesus Christ, in whom is our salvation, life and resurrection, through whom we are saved and delivered.*
