Fr. Michael's Musings

There are two primary images for the Holy Spirit used in the readings today.

The first is Fire: a powerful image that can seem to indicate destruction and raw, unstoppable power.



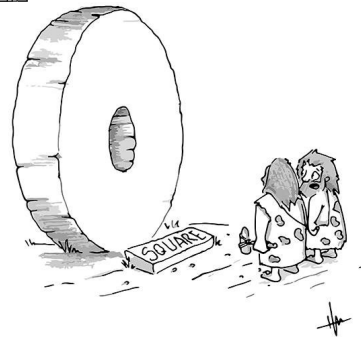
That seems apt, but fire is also an image of gentle warmth, light and protection from predators and the terrors of the night.

The second is Wind: Now this can seem to be about gentle breezes and the mysterious movements of air that moves creation. But wind can also be that driving force that can tear things apart, uproot trees, throw cars around and level cities.

Is there a similarity? Of course, both images can be gentle and peaceful and both can be destructive and powerful. Thus is the Holy Spirit given to us, as wind and fire,.
