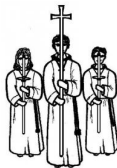

**Catholic Daughters** will be raising awareness of abuse and accepting donations for the annual Lifesaver Project on the weekend of May 27 & 28.

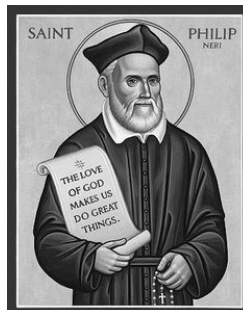

On Friday, the Church invites us to celebrate the Feast of Saint Philip Neri.

St. Philip Neri was an Italian priest who died in the city of Rome on May 26, 1595. So influential was his priesthood that he is often call "The Third

Apostle of Rome," after Ss. Peter and Paul.

But today I would like us to remember another aspect of his life...he is also known as "The Apostle of Joy." He was so universally known for his good will, light heart and joy, that he transformed the world around him with his smile.

He once said, "excessive sadness seldom springs from any other source than pride;" meaning that if we focus too much on ourselves, our problems, our faults, our sins, we lose the joy that comes from the Holy Spirit. He bids us look outward and rejoice.

As school draws to a close and the relaxation of summer begins (at least theoretically), it is good to honor this holy man who reminds us to stop every so often, enjoy our lives, laugh and not take ourselves too seriously.
