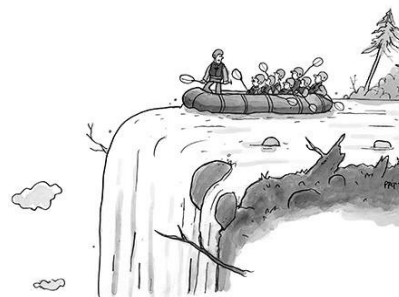
Trinity shows the Three at table, united, and a place for us with Them; a beautiful thought, indeed.
